You can graph up to five equations at a time.

Do you like cryptograms? A cryptogram is a word puzzle in which a quotation, saying, or witticism has been encoded by substituting every letter with another letter. There are 750 cryptogram quotes, plus you can add your own. If you need help, you can get a one letter hint, or see the frequencies of letters and 2 and 3 letter combinations. And, if you like to solve other cryptograms (such as the ones in the newspaper), you can enter them into the program and solve them using the program's interface instead of a pencil and paper.
