Each copy of *TellMe* is packaged and distributed as a *TellMe* Starter Kit, which includes the basic search software, plus a copy of several dozen DataBases designed to make *TellMe* useful right out of the blocks. Several data templates ("DataConnections") are also supplied to allow the user to enter personal information for use with *TellMe*.

The real value of *TellMe* is driven by the availability of Add-On DataBases and DataConnections that allow the user to expand the depth and breadth of information they can access using *TellMe*'s simple interface. Iceberg distributes Add-Ons electronically via its Internet web site (<http://www.IcebergSoftware.com>) and a selection of commercial on-line services. For those customers without on-line capabilities, Add-Ons will also be made available on magnetic media, and may be ordered direct from Iceberg at 1.888.283.5563 (1.888.2TELLME).

## ***Product Descriptions***

### **WhenIs**

*WhenIs* -- a *TellMe* database which provides information about upcoming events: holidays, sporting events, entertainment specials, tradeshowes, etc. Helps you keep track of events you may want to attend or watch on television. *WhenIs* is not sold as a separate data base; instead, it is supplied free of charge to registered *TellMe* users. If you have not yet registered your copy of *TellMe*, please do so via our web site at [www.IcebergSoftware.com](http://www.IcebergSoftware.com) or call Iceberg at 888.283.5563 (1.888.2TELLME) and get a free copy of the *WhenIs* data base.

### **Financial Matters**

*Financial Terms* -- Provides definitions for 3,000+ terms used in financial markets. The definitions includes range from such fundamental words as *stock* to more specialized concepts such as *lookback call option*.

*Business Reference* -- A general-purpose tool for people in business. Includes

- sections on business law, government, communications, corporate administration, finance, human resources, manufacturing, marketing, office management, and international

business

- directories of resources (such as industry newsletters or environmental organizations) and potential suppliers or business partners
- tables of reference data, including the Forbes 400 wealthiest people, the Inc. 500 fastest-growing companies, etc.

*Currency Exchange Rates* -- Provides current exchange rates between the dollar and foreign currencies. Requires the user to have access to the internet.

## **Geography**

*World Geography Reference* -- includes demographic, governmental, economic and historical information for countries around the world.

*US Cities: Complete* -- provides area codes, ZIP codes, time zone and population for 50,000-plus cities in the US.

## **Travel**

*Traveler's Resource* -- includes information useful to travelers:

- telephone country codes (to and from foreign countries)
- time zones, currencies, languages for other countries
- airport information
- diplomatic personnel and embassies
- mileage between cities
- temperature and weather by season

*Foreign Cities Weather* -- a subset of the *Traveler's Resource*, providing average monthly temperature and number of rain days for cities overseas.

*US Cities Weather* -- a subset of the *Traveler's Resource*, providing average monthly temperature and number of rain days for U.S. cities.

*US Cities Mileages* -- Provides distance (in miles) information between 300 U.S. cities.

## **Kids**

*Web Addresses (URLs) for Kids* -- Locations on the Internet's World Wide Web, selected for their appeal to young people.

## **Data Connections**

*Symantec: Act!* -- Allows you to use *TellMe* to access your information which is stored in Symantec's Act! Contact management software application.

*Lotus: Organizer* -- Allows you to use *TellMe* to access your information which is stored in

Lotus Organizer.

*Other Personal Information Managers* -- Under development. Please send e-mail to [Suggestions@IcebergSoftware.com](mailto:Suggestions@IcebergSoftware.com) and let us know which PIM you use.

## **Writing Tools**

*AHD Dictionary* -- Provides definitions, pronunciation and etymology for 34,000-plus words.

*Webster's School & Office Dictionary* -- Provides definitions, pronunciation and etymology for 60,000-plus words.

*Quotations* -- Includes 5,600 quotations; based on Simpson's Contemporary Quotations

*Spell Checker* -- Allows you to check the spelling of a word, even if your word processor is not running.

*Abbreviations* -- Find the abbreviation you need for a word or phrase, or look up the meaning of an abbreviation that you don't recognize.

*Biographical Summaries* -- Provides a quick reference to check "Who was so-and-so?"

*Geographical Summaries* -- Helps you find out "Where on earth is such-a-place?"

*Foreign words and phrases* -- Now, when you cannot decipher that unfamiliar phrase from the context of the passage you are reading, you can look it up quickly and easily!

## **Directory Assistance**

*Online Directory* -- Where to find information online. Tells you which online service(s) have information for which information providers, and what command to use to access the information.

*Internet Web Addresses (URLs)* -- Locations on the Internet's World Wide Web.

*The Beige Pages* -- Information about companies in the personal computer industry: products, technical support resources, phones & faxes, addresses (both physical and electronic). Includes hardware and software suppliers.

*Who Knows What* -- A directory of thousand's information resources organized under 500 distinct categories.

Once there, you can choose the "Registration" item, and submit your registration online. If you register over the Internet, you can receive your copy of WhenIs immediately, via download from the Web site (invoked automatically after you've registered). Unless the Internet is really busy when you register, this download should take less than 5 minutes using a 9600 baud modem. (You are responsible for paying any Internet costs for the time needed to download the WhenIs file.)

2. Alternatively, TellMe contains a registration capability: from the Help menu, choose the item entitled "Register TellMe". Once you have completed the form, you can print it out and then either mail or fax it to Iceberg. The fax number for registrations is 800-671-5830. When you give us your e-mail address on your registration form, we will send your free copy of the WhenIs database via electronic mail. (A shipping and handling fee of \$5 applies if you need a floppy-disk copy of WhenIs sent via mail; please include your Visa or MasterCard account number and expiration date, or mail a check payable to Iceberg Software, L.L.C.)

## How to use *TellMe*

*TellMe* is a personal data retrieval tool that helps you find information that you have stored on your computer or network.

To learn how to use help, Press F1.

### *Contents for How to Use Help*

If you are new to Help, choose Help Basics. Use the scroll bar to view information not visible in the Help window.

### *To choose a Help topic*

Click the underlined topic you want to view. Or press TAB to select the topic, and then press ENTER.

### *Help Basics*

Windows Help offers a quick way to find information, such as how to perform a particular task. Within a Help topic, there may be one or more jumps, which you can click (or select and press ENTER) to display a new Help topic.

You can move, resize, maximize, or minimize the Help window, just like any other window.

To return to Contents for How To Use Help, choose the Contents button.

### *Sample Screen Layout*

### *Commands and Buttons*

#### **File Menu Commands**

Use the scroll bar to see more commands.

#### **Print**

Sends entire search string and result directly to selected printer. For example:

*the phone number for Bob Smith is 703.555.1234*



Cancel is supported.

## **Fax**

Sends entire search string and result directly to the selected fax send device. For example:

*the phone number for Bob Smith is 703.555.1234*

Cancel is supported. The fax device must be in *TellMe* (use Settings | Preferences) and installed as a supported printer in the Windows Control Panel.

## **Dial**

Dials phone number displayed in the Answer Box via the modem. The dialing configuration for the modem is established in **Settings** followed by **Preferences**.

## **Save As**

Sends entire search string and result to a disk file (which you select) in ASCII text (.TXT) format.

**Exit** (terminates the application)

## **Edit Menu Commands**

### **Cut**

Copies the search result (as displayed in the Answer Box) into the clipboard and clears the display in the Answer Box. For example, the clipboard might contain:

*703.555.1234*

### **Copy**

Copies the search result (as displayed in the Answer Box) into the clipboard and leaves Answer Box display intact. For example, the clipboard might contain:

*703.555.1234*

### **Paste**

Enters existing clipboard contents into the Value Box to facilitate the next *TellMe* search.

## **Data Menu Commands**

### **Source**

Displays the source of the data (from the immediately previous search) in the Answer Box.

### **Create Starter Kit Diskette**

This command will create a copy of the TellMe Starter Kit by copying the necessary files to a diskette. Please share copies of the Starter Kit with whomever you like.

## **Settings Menu Commands**

Use the scroll bar to see more commands.

### **Hotkeys Setup**

*This feature is not implemented in this version of TellMe.*

### **Preferences**

Enables user to use TellMe to dial through a modem, and to link his existing fax application to *TellMe* by defining the fax device.

#### ***Modem/Dial Setup***

Enables the user to configure the modem to dial phone numbers that are displayed in the Answer Box at the conclusion of a *TellMe* search. Note: The user must have a telephone handset connected to the modem so he can talk to the desired party once the modem completes the dialing procedure.

#### **Port**

User can select from the following serial ports: COM1, COM2, COM3 or COM4 (indicating where the modem is connected).

#### **Dial String**

User specifies a modem command (if any) required to initiate dialing by the modem.

#### **Dial Prefix**

User selects a numeric prefix (if any) required for all calls.

### **Dial Prefix (Long Distance)**

User selects a numeric prefix (if any) required for long distance dialing.

### **Area Code**

User specifies the area code for his current location; this allows TellMe to *not* dial that area code, even if the value is stored in the database being searched.

### ***Interface Type***

*This feature is not implemented in this version of TellMe.*

### **Fax**

Enables the user to specify the fax driver to be used by *TellMe* for faxing output (see the File menu). The fax device must be already installed as a supported printer in the Windows Control Panel.

### **Enter Customer Number**

Iceberg Software assigns a unique customer number to every *TellMe* user when they register their copy of *TellMe*. This customer number allows Iceberg to better track customers, what DataBases they have purchased, preferences, configuration, etc. When you register with Iceberg and receive your Customer Number, please enter it into *TellMe* as soon as possible.

### **Always on Top**

Toggle command: when "on" the *TellMe* application window (either in minimized or full-sized form) will appear "on top" of all other applications. When a check mark appears directly to the left of the **Always on Top** menu item, the option is "on"; when the check mark disappears, the option is off. Note that this feature is useful on Windows 3.x systems; for Windows 95 users, the Windows system Taskbar provides a similar capability.

### **Run at Startup**

Toggle command: when "on" *TellMe* will be loaded into memory every time Windows is launched. When "off", *TellMe* must be launched manually by selecting its icon and double clicking on it (or clicking on it once and pressing the "enter" key). When a check mark appears directly to the left of the **Run at Startup** menu item, the option is "on", when the check mark disappears, the option is off.

## **Toolbar**

Toggle command: turns display of the Toolbar (which is located directly beneath the File menu) on and off. When a check mark appears directly to the left of the **Toolbar** menu item, the toolbar display option is "on", when the check mark disappears, the toolbar display option is off. The display is turned on and off by selecting that item with the mouse.

## **Help Menu Commands**

### **Contents**

Provides access to the Help information for *TellMe*.

### **Search for Help On...**

Allows the user to search the keywords in the Help information for *TellMe*.

### **Register TellMe**

Allows the user to enter information needed to register a copy of *TellMe* with Iceberg Software. Once the information has been entered, the resulting registration form can be printed and mailed or faxed directly to Iceberg. See also [Please register your copy of TellMe](#)

### **Add-on Descriptions**

Provides information about add-on products (additional DataBases and DataConnections) which are available for use with *TellMe*.

### **Order Add-Ons**

Allows the user to enter information needed to order add-on products from Iceberg Software. Once the information has been entered, the resulting order form can be printed and mailed or faxed directly to Iceberg.

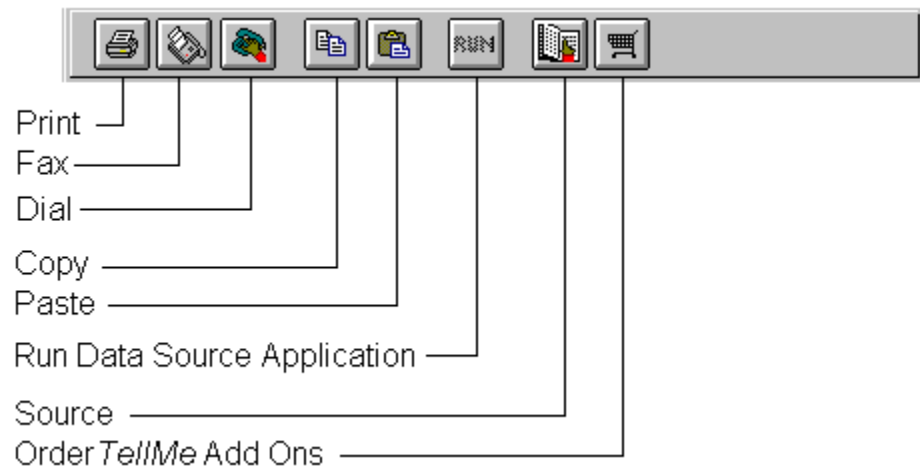
### **About TellMe**

are designed to provide convenient access to frequently used *TellMe* commands.

## How to add your own Data to **TellMe**

To help you put your own information into *TellMe*, the Starter Kit includes four Data Templates -- these are regular Microsoft Excel spreadsheets (.XLS files) which you can edit using Excel (version 5 or version 7) to contain your own data. The four Data Templates are

AddrBook.XLS	Address Book
SerialNr.XLS	Serial Numbers and Warranty Information
OfficeEx.XLS	Office Extensions
MyWallet.XLS	My Wallet

The Address Book allows you to store names, addresses, phone and fax numbers, and e-mail addresses for your friends, family members and business associates. The Serial Numbers file helps you keep track of serial numbers and warranty expiration dates for items you own (appliances, consumer electronics, etc.). The Office Extensions file allows you to store telephone extensions (voice and/or fax) and e-mail addresses for the colleagues who work in your office. The My Wallet file lets you keep personal data (insurance policy numbers, credit card numbers, frequent flyer accounts, etc.)

To edit any of these files, you only need to start Excel, then use the File | Open command to open the file you wish to edit. [Note that the files are stored in the "Template" subdirectory of your TellMe directory; if you used the default location for TellMe (C:\TELLME), then the Excel templates are stored in C:\TELLME\TEMPLATE.] Once you have opened the file, you may add or correct any of the information in the file. Then simply use the File | Save command to save your work. *Be sure to use the File | Close or File | Exit commands in Excel before you try to access the file using TellMe; if Excel still has the data file open, you will get an error message from TellMe (Registry error -- Unable to find xls file.).* The following table will help you know which Excel file to edit for a given TellMe request:

<b><u>Filename</u></b>	<b><u>TellMe Request</u></b>
AddrBook.xls	Address for Name
AddrBook.xls	Phone for Name
SerialNr.xls	Serial # for Manufacturer/Model #
SerialNr.xls	Warranty Pd / Date for Manufacturer/Model #
MyWallet.xls	Account Number for Issuer
OfficeEx.xls	Extension for Name
OfficeEx.xls	Name for Extension
OfficeEx.xls	e-mail for Name
OfficeEx.xls	Fax for Name

Remember that you must use Excel version 5 or version 7 to edit these Data Templates; earlier versions of Excel are not able to save the .XLS file in the correct file format. When you install these versions of Excel, they automatically install the necessary OLE2 support files (OLE2.DLL, STORAGE.DLL, and COMPOBJ.DLL) in your \WINDOWS\SYSTEM directory.

The current version of TellMe (Version 1.0) requires that Excel be installed on the PC where TellMe is running in order to use the above features. We are planning to remove this restriction in the future; this would allow you to create (or edit) your data files on a PC which

includes Excel, then to distribute the data files to other PCs which would not need Excel to access those data files. Once this version is available, you can get it from our World Wide Web home page on the Internet at:

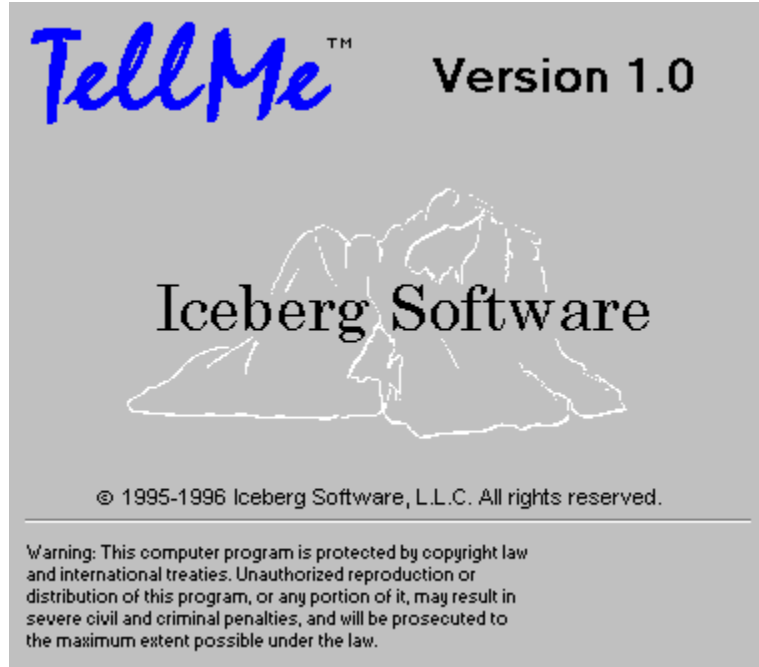

## **DataBases**

DataBases are the special compilations of information which are sold as TellMe add-ons, to allow TellMe to access this information on their own computers or networks. These DataBases must be obtained by licensing them (and usually by paying a fee *for each user*) from the publisher of each DataBase. DataBases may *not* be copied or distributed to other users.

## **Personal Information Manager (PIM)**

One of a group of software products, developed to allow PC users to store their own personal information in a PC. This information typically includes

- schedule information

- list(s) of "things to do"

- personal contacts: names, addresses, telephone numbers for friends, colleagues, customers, etc.

Examples of PIM products are

- ECCO* from NetManage

- Organizer* from Lotus

- Schedule+* from Microsoft

- ACT!* from Symantec

TellMe will allow you to access your PIM information without having to load the PIM program.

## DataConnections

DataConnections are the special software components which allow TellMe to access data from other applications, such as reference data bases or a [Personal Information Manager \(PIM\)](#). These DataConnections must be obtained by licensing them (and usually by paying a fee *for each user*) from the developer of each DataConnection. DataConnections may *not* be copied or distributed to other users.

## The **TellMe** Starter Kit
