Self service check-in at San Francisco and Los Angeles



No lines, no lists, no waiting!

Now when you take the Shuttle by United from Los Angeles International Airport or San Francisco International Airport, choosing your seat is as easy as touch and go.

Just step up to one of our friendly self-service check-in kiosks, insert the credit card you purchased your E-Ticket with, or your Mileage Plus Premier Card, then select a seat on the screen. Seconds later, you're headed for the gate with a freshly printed boarding pass in your pocket.

When you're flying from Los Angeles...

There are three self service check-in kiosks in Los Angeles International Airport. The first is next to the Customer Service center in the Shuttle satellite 8 area. There are also two machines located just beyond Shuttle gate 80.

When you're flying from San Francisco...

There are several self service check-in kiosks in San Francisco International Airport. You can find them in the lobby next to the 1K check-in position and one at the Shuttle check-in area. There are also two units located across from gate 77 and one across from gate 78.

- Next to the Customer Service Center, across from Gates 80A and 80B
- Near Shuttle Gates 80A and 80B

At San Francisco International Airport (SFO):

- In the lobby next to the Shuttle check-in positions and the 1K check-in counter
- Across from Gate 77
- Across from Gate 78

Look for these new features on United Connection in the summer of 1996!

- **Mileage Plus[®] upgrades**

Request Mileage Plus upgrades on United Connection using Mileage Plus one-way upgrade kits. No need to contact United Reservations or your travel agent! The queuing system currently used by the Apollo Reservation System will accept your request for a one-way upgrade, saving you time.

- **More Fare ShopperSM functionality**

When shopping for the lowest fare, United Connection will search for twice as many competitive fares as before, to save you money!

- **Interface improvements**

A variety of user interface improvements will make using United Connection even easier!

- **Access United Connection via CompuServe and the Microsoft Network**

An earlier version of United Connection has been on CompuServe since April, 1995, providing you with the ability to reserve travel on over 500 airlines. The newer disk-based version of United Connection with all of its enhancements will be available on CompuServe in the summer of 1996. Now in addition to reserving travel on over 500 airlines, you will be able to reserve hotels and rental cars when you use United Connection on CompuServe.

In addition, the Microsoft Network will begin carrying United Connection in the summer of 1996 as a file you can download on your PC.
