

### **Instructions for the Blackjack spreadsheet**

- 1.) The user must download the Atlantic City Font from the graphics area of America Online (Shareware). He must then install the font by moving it to his font folder.
- 2.) It is strongly recommended that the user make a backup copy of this spreadsheet, because if he inadvertently violates the advice herein, he may very easily ruin his spreadsheet.
- 3.) Absolutely before the spreadsheet is used in the least, the user must load the blackjack macros. (Claris' File menu, Macros, Load Macros, then select Blackjack macros from the open list).
- 4.) Make sure Auto Calc under the Calculate Menu is unchecked (off) for this spreadsheet.
- 5.) The keys associated with the macros are F13, F14, and F15.
  - F13 will start a new round or game.
  - F14 is optional; it allows the player to draw (or be "hit") with up to three additional cards.
  - F15 is used to allow the player to stand or freeze and end the round.

You can depress F13 at any time to start a new game, but F14 should not be depressed after F15. (In other words, you should start a game before drawing cards!)
- 6.) The user absolutely should NOT depress any other keys. The user MUST NOT scroll the window. He MUST NOT change the size of the rows or columns. Taking these actions and then using the macros will result in the spreadsheet being ruined.
- 7.) The number of cards played by the player or dealer is limited to 5.
- 8.) If necessary, you can do a forced quit of ClarisWorks by depressing Command-Option-esc.
