## Game Objective

In Gold Hunt, you are in search of a treasure hidden underground. You must try to find the treasure before you run out of energy and in the least number of tries possible.

## Game Instructions

Use the mouse to position the "X" in one of the squares, or you may use the arrow keys on the keyboard. Press the left mouse button or the space bar to dig a hole. If where you dug is not where the gold is buried, the computer will let you know how many steps you are away from the gold. One step is equal to one square and you may step horizontally, vertically, or diagonally. By digging where you already dug, you can find out how far away you were during that point of the game.

## Game Options

There are three levels of play. The size of the steps determine what level you are playing - level 1 is easiest while level 3 is hardest. The default is level 2.

You may change the energy level by choosing "Energy..." in the "Game" menu. The default is 20.
