Part 1, the text input area, is the place where you can type three lines of ten characters which whill be transformed to ANSI later on. Also a destination file must be specified. This can be done by using the file requester.

1.5 Part 2

This part gives you information about the active library. Its name, version and the characters available are displayed.

There is also a possibility to use another ANSI font, by activating an external library. First type in its name or use the file requester. Then load the external library. When the library is correct, the new library information will be shown.

Yes, here the action starts.

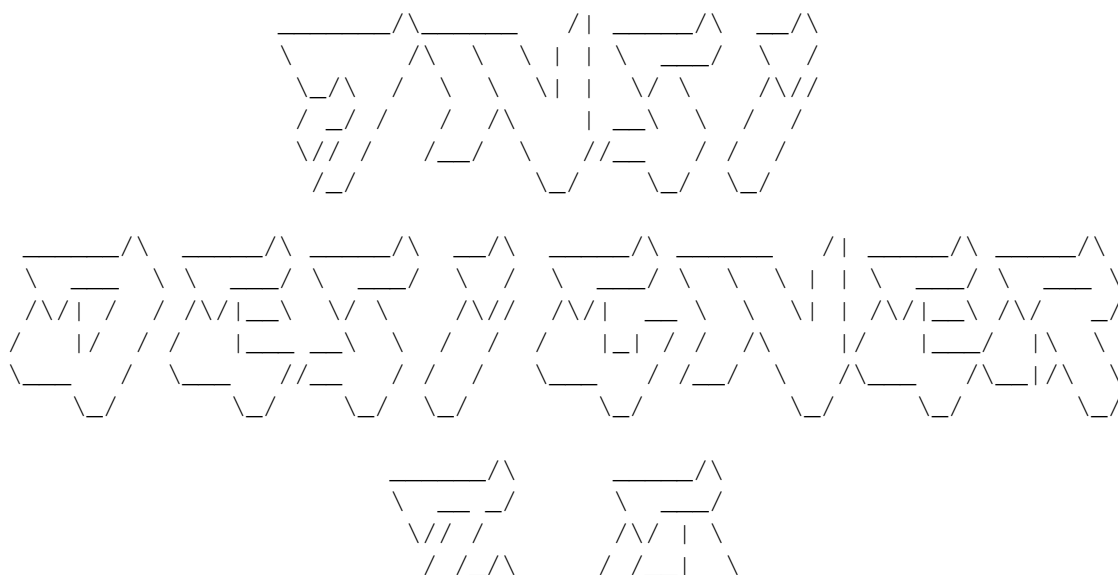
- o `START` transforms the ASCII lines to ANSI and writes the file.

- o `SHOW` show the ANSI result.

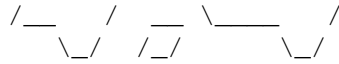
Last and least the status messages will be printed here.
