

“Getting Started” Read Me

This folder has been created to help you easily and effectively access the information on the Apple Reference & Presentations Library CD (ARPL).

The "Getting Started" folder contains the following:

ARPL Install Script or Installer: Both of these files will quickly and effectively allow you to install all required fonts and INITs to view and print information found on ARPL. In addition, it now allows you to install applications such as: HyperCard 2.1, Home, and the CD-ROM Setup 3.2.

Once you have double-clicked either ARPL Install Script or Install, you can

- 1) Click “Install” to install all fonts, INITs, and applications to your startup hard drive.
- 2) Click “Customize”, select only those items you would like to install, and click “Easy Install”.

All fonts, INITs, and applications with the same name will be “written over” in their respective folders.

ARPL CD Related Fonts: This folder contains all fonts which are required to view and print* all information found on ARPL. Fonts included in this folder are:

- 1) Apple Garamond
- 2) Helvetica
- 3) Helvetica Condensed*
- 4) Merriam Square
- 5) Times

CD-ROM Setup 3.2: To access your CD-ROM drive, the CD-ROM software must be installed on the startup drive. This folder contains the latest version of this software and instructions on how to use it.

* The ARPL CD Partner edition does not include the Helvetica Condensed printer font.

HyperCard 2.1: The ARPL CD front-end stack has been created in HyperCard 2.1. To be sure you have HyperCard 2.1, follow the steps below:

1) Use the ARPL Install Script to install HyperCard and Home on your startup drive,

or

- 2) Remove all previous versions of HyperCard and Home cards on all working drives;
- 3) Double click on the file HyperCard 2.1.sea;
- 4) A dialog box will appear asking you which drive you want to save the self-extracting HyperCard 2.1 file to;
- 5) Select the drive and click ok.

The HyperCard 2.1.sea file contains the following information:

- 1) HyperCard 2.1
- 2) Home Stack
- 3) HyperCard fonts
- 4) HyperCard Release Notes

MoviePlayer: This is the QuickTime INIT. Use the ARPL Install Script or Installer to install it onto your startup hard drive or put it manually into the “Extensions” folder within your System folder.

1992 ARPL Persuasions Templates: To enable ARPL CD users to mix and match slides from different Persuasion presentations, standardized Persuasion templates and autotemplates have been created in both color and black and white formats. Use the templates to create new presentations for the ARPL CD or update your existing presentations using the autotemplate.
