

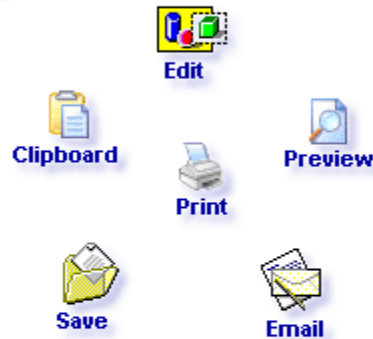
With SnagIt, taking screen captures is as simple as 1-2-3!

Start Tour

Input

Input menu options allow you to choose exactly what you want to capture on the desktop.



Output

Output menu options allow you to choose what happens to the capture once it is taken.

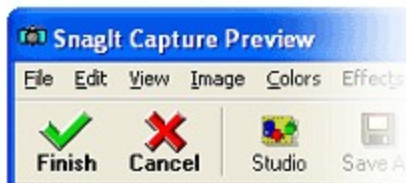


Capture

2. After the capture, within the Preview Window, choose:



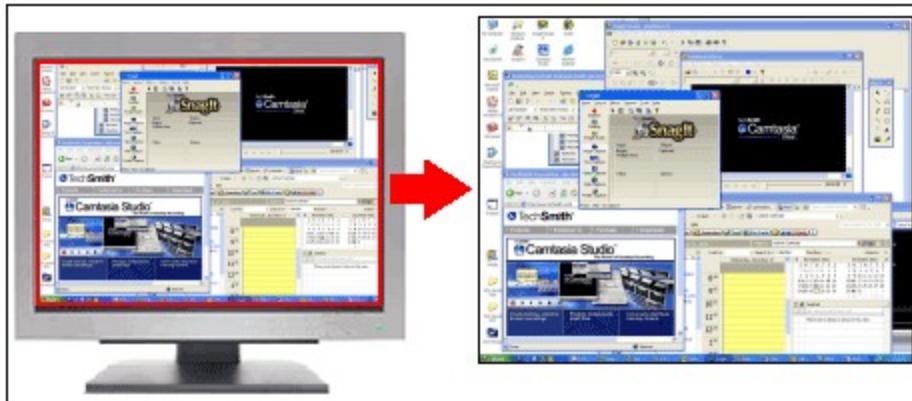
Finish to send capture to output.

Cancel to delete the capture.

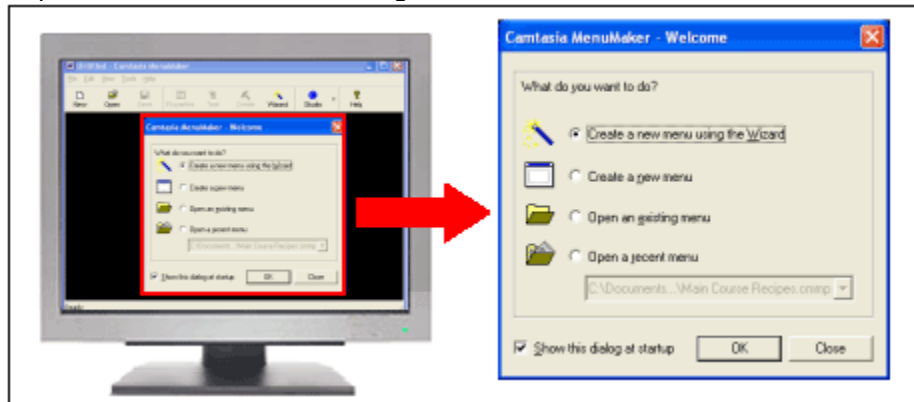
Entire Screen

Capture everything that shows on your computer desktop including the cursor if desired.



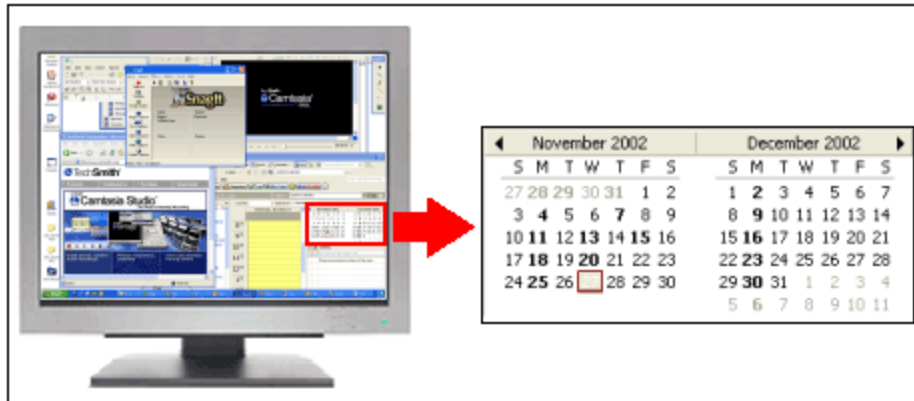
Window

Capture a selected window, dialog box, etc.



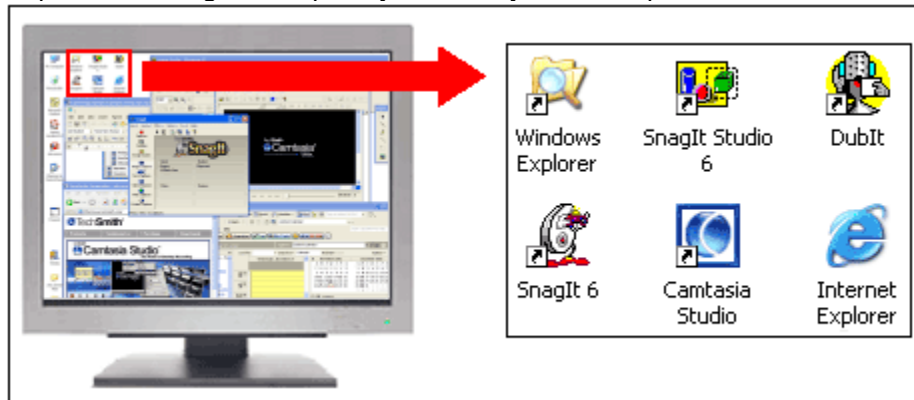
Object

Capture a specific item on your computer desktop such as a button, icon, toolbar, dialog box, etc.



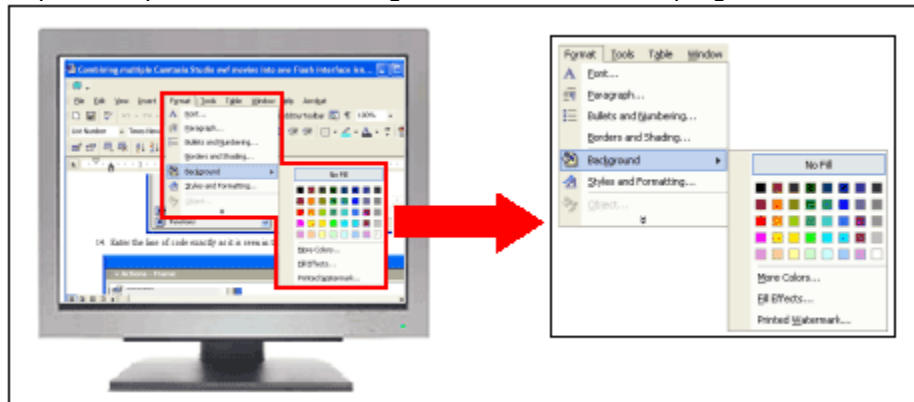
Rectangular Region

Capture a rectangular shape anywhere on your desktop.



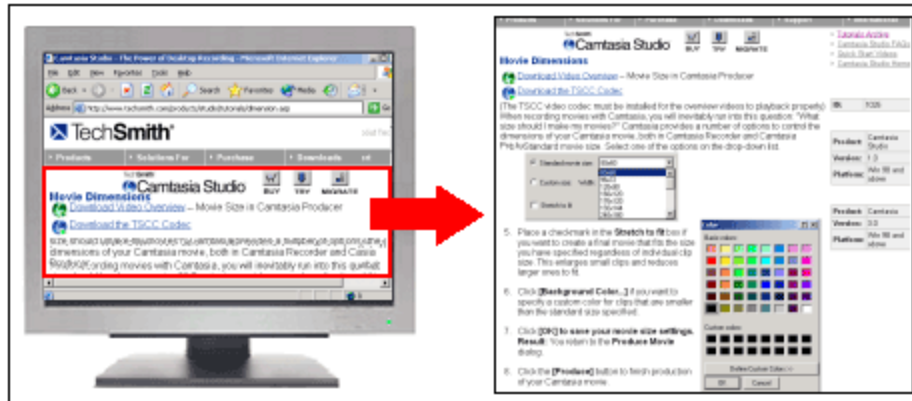
Menu

Capture dropdown and cascading menus from Windows programs.



Scrolling Window

Capture the contents of a window, including the part not seen, both vertically and horizontally.



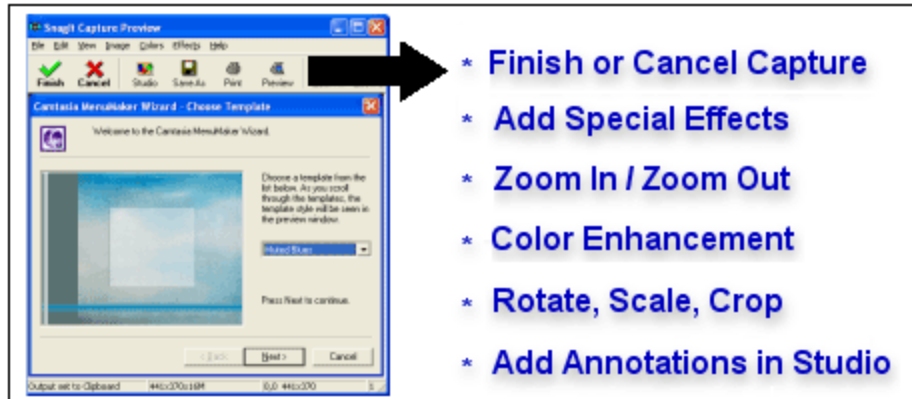
Game (DirectX)

Capture scenes from DirectX games.



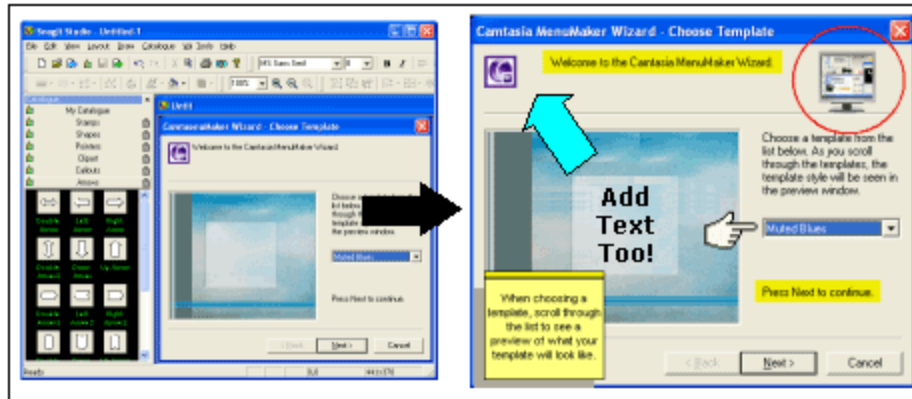
Capture Preview Window

The Capture Preview Window allows you to view and edit the images you capture before saving them.



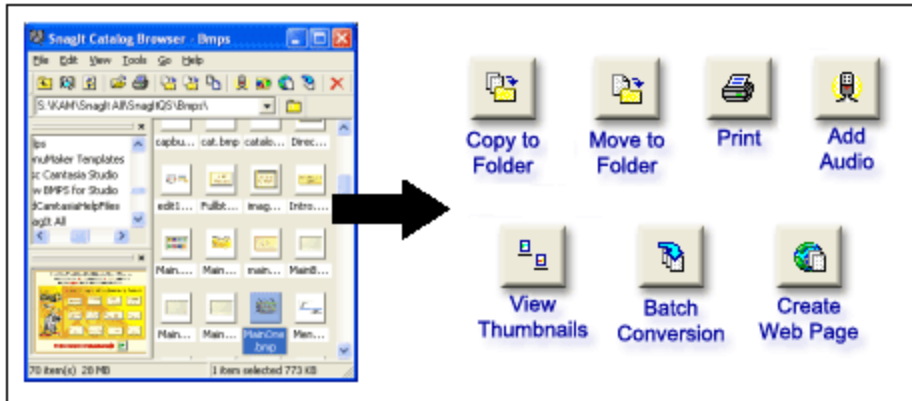
Edit in SnagIt Studio

SnagIt Add-Ins

SnagIt add-ins are small custom toolbars in your Microsoft® Word®, PowerPoint®, Excel®, Internet Explorer®, Windows Explorer®, and Adobe FrameMaker® applications.

With just one click of the mouse, SnagIt add-ins make it extra easy to capture anything on your screen while giving you complete control over every aspect of the screen capture process – all from within your familiar desktop working environment - all with just one click of the mouse.

Developer's Tools

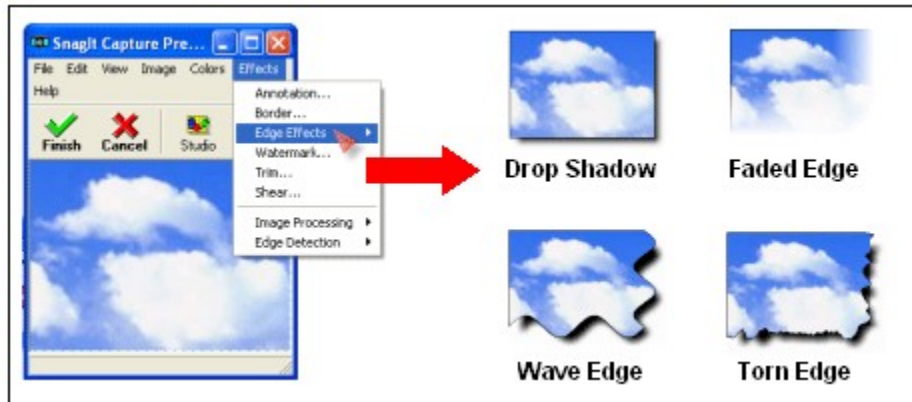
SnagIt can now be accessed as a COM server. This means you can access SnagIt's capture functionality from any programming language that supports COM.

Developers using Visual Basic, Visual C/C++, Visual Studio.Net, Delphi, C++Builder can now embed and control SnagIt directly in their applications.

Custom Edge Effects

SnagIt's Custom Edge Effects contain a wide variety of filter options for altering the edges of your screen capture. This includes a torn, faded, or wave look along with the ability to add a custom frame and drop shadow. The Edge Effects can be applied as a filter before you capture or within Preview Window after you take your capture.



Creating Icons

SnagIt allows you to take a screen capture and save it as an icon (.ico) file. Icon capture options include the ability to append numerous sized icons to one icon file, automatic file naming, and more.
