Introduction

Greetings Mortal and welcome to QuickFyre.

QuickFyre is an anonymous emailer \ mail bomber.

I wrote QuickFyre mainly as a further development of OMENz, DiViNE INTERVENTiON]['s mail bomber. QuickFyre uses virtually exactly the same technique as OMENz, but I've added in more display information, so that you'll be able to tell exactly what is going on.

Although QuickFyre is not quite the all-in-one demolition package DiViNE INTERVENTiON][is, it's a sweet piece of software that is a purely design, and not functionality, based improvement over OMENz.

WARNING : Email sent will not be entirely anonymous - it will still display your IP address. If you are running a program that runs an IDENT server, like most IRC clients, at the same time, the recipient will be able to see your username.

Bottom line - don't use this baby while you're on IRC. 8)

Using QuickFyre

Using QuickFyre is simplicity itself. Fill in the target's email address in the Target field, the email address you want it to appear that the message came from in the Sender field, a subject in the Subject field, and the mail server you want to use to send the mails in the Server field. It's generally best to use your own ISP's server here, it'll be a lot faster.

Then, type in your message, and set the number of mails you want to send. (Anywhere up to 32,767) Then (difficulty of difficulties) click the Mail button! You'll see a status of the mail, as well as a percentage and the actual messaging going on with the server. (This in particular is the main enhancement over OMENz) To halt the mail bombing at any time, just click the 'Stop' button.

The Coding of QuickFyre

QuickFyre was coded using Borland C++ v5.02, using (and extending) the same NetSocket classes I used for DiViNE INTERVENTiON][. I didn't quite go into hibernation as I did during the coding of DiViNE, as I wrote QuickFyre mostly as something interesting to do shortly before final exams.

The actual technique and a lot of the methodology was transferred from OMENz. (DiViNE's mail bomber) The most important addition as far as technique goes was the running of the mail bomb functions in a separate thread as opposed to in the main program execution thread.

The WatchfulEye bit was added in as a part of a Java Applet I never quite finished. At some point, probably quite soon, I'll release it and it's source code as an OWL thread based class for general use.

During the coding of QuickFyre, I listened to massive amounts of old U2 (Joshua Tree mostly) and Nirvana. Edgar, my goldfish, deserves credit for the inspirational ideas and constructive criticism he contributed towards QuickFyre. :)
