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## **File menu**

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## **File > Send to**

**Use this action to send files to other programs.**

Choose the file(s) and select **File > Send to**.  
and then select the program you want to open the file(s) in.  
You can select between **Anokee, Fixer, Flyer** or **Mail Recipient (as attachment)**.

## File > Print

### To print files:

1. Select the file(s) you want to print.
2. Select **File > Print > Singles/Thumbnails** from the menu.  
**OR** Right-click and select **Print > Singles/Thumbnails**.  
**OR** Click the arrow next to the **Print** button in the toolbar and select between **Singles/Thumbnails**.
3. A preview window opens. You may select to save the print selection by clicking the **Save Report** button. You can open the report later with the **Open Report** button. Use the arrow buttons to scroll through the print selection.
4. Click the **Print** button to print your selection.

When inside the preview window you can enlarge and decrease the view by clicking and holding down the left mouse button while dragging up and down.

You can also move the image in the preview window by clicking and holding down the right mouse button and dragging.

## **File > Print Setup**

### **To set the printer settings:**

1. Select **File > Print Setup** from the menu.
2. Click the **Name** combo box, and select a printer.
3. Click the **Paper Size** combo box, and select the right paper size.
4. Select the printing orientation, **Landscape** or **Portrait**.
5. For detailed settings click the **Properties** button.

## **File > Exit**

### **To close the Illuminator:**

Select **File > Exit** from the menu.

## **Edit > Rotate**

### **To rotate the image:**

1. Select the image.
2. Select **Edit > Rotate** from the menu.
3. Repeat until the image turns right.



## Edit > Delete

### To delete files:

1. Select the file(s) to delete.
  2. Select **Edit > Delete** from the menu.  
**OR** Right-click and select **Delete**.
  3. You are then asked if you want to remove the selected file(s) from the Viewer.
  4. Click **OK** to perform the operation, or **Cancel** if you want to cancel it.
- You can also select the **Delete original file** check box to delete the file permanently from your computer.



After you click **OK** the operation can not be cancelled.

## Edit > Select All

### To select all the files:

1. Select **View > Thumbnail View** from the menu.
2. Select **Edit > Select all** from the menu.

### To select individual files:

1. Click on a file to select it.
2. Press and hold <**Ctrl**>.
3. Select the files.

### To select files next to each other:

1. Click on a file to select it.
2. Press and hold <**Shift**>.
3. Click the last file in the sequence.

Click on any file to deselect.

## Introduction

Create your own slideshows and exhibitions in the Viewer.

### **The main functions of the Illuminator:**

- ▶ You can select one file, a file collection or files from different albums and put into one big slideshow.
- ▶ You can import files quickly from anywhere in your computer, from CD-Roms and floppy disks to put into your show.
- ▶ You can use this powerful tool for viewing files, spicing up presentations, entertaining relatives, friends or clients.
- ▶ You can view your thumbnails in great sharpness and change your thumbnail size up to 200 pixels without reducing their quality.
- ▶ You can change the background color of the slideshow and change the time between the slides.

## File > Options

### To set options for slideshows:

Change the background color of the slideshow by clicking the appropriate color box. After you click a color box, a window appears where you can select the color you prefer.

If you want to create your own color click the **Define Custom Colors**.

Enter a value or drag the slider to increase or decrease the thumbnail size.

Click the **FileTypes** button to set the criteria that will be used by default when the **Illuminator** scans for files. You can also add and remove file types from the list. Restore to the original settings by clicking the **Restore to defaults** button.

After you click the **Slideshow** button you can enter the number of seconds you want between slides in the **Slideshow delay** box. Select the **Loop** box if you want the show to run again each time it finishes.

With this command your images appear as thumbnails.  
Select **Tools > Thumbnail View** or right-click  
and select **Thumbnail View**.



## Toolbar overview

The toolbar appears at the top of the application window, below the menu bar. It provides quick mouse access to many menu commands. The buttons in the toolbar have an icon and a label to help you identify its function.

If you pause for a second with the mouse cursor over a button, Anokee displays a tool tip, providing a description of the button.

You can also right-click to get a pop up menu with commands.

# Illuminator

**Find all your missing files with the Anokee Illuminator.  
Even files you didn't know existed on your computer will re-appear, as if by magic.**

1. Select **File > Illuminator** from the menu.
2. The **Illuminator** welcomes. Click the **Next** button.
3. Click on the drive you wish the Wizard to scan. If you don't want to scan subfolders, click the Scan subfolders checkbox to deselect it.
4. Follow the instructions and click **Next** until you finish your selection, then press the **Finish** button.
5. The **Illuminator** now begins scanning your files. If you wish, you can cancel the process by clicking the **Cancel** button in the lower right corner of the Viewer.

When scanning is complete, you are asked if you wish to send your files to Anokee.

If you click **Yes**, a window opens allowing you to select a project in which to place your files. You can select a separate project for your images, videos, sound and other files.

If you press **No**, you can always choose the files you wish to send to Anokee later, by selecting **File > Send to > Anokee**.

## Changing language

**To change Anokee to another language:**

1. Select **Tools > Languages** from the menu.
2. Select the language you want to use.
3. Click **OK**.

## Slideshow operations

**Open Slideshow:** Opens an existing slideshow.

**Save Slideshow:** To save a slideshow for later use

**Add to Slideshow:** Select the images you want to appear in the slideshow and select **File > Add to Slideshow**.

## To take a copy of an image:

1. Click on the image and select **Edit > Copy**.
2. Now you can paste the image to a program of your choice.

Click this button to open the slideshow window where you select the pictures you want in your show.
