

Talk Now! 32-bit for Windows 95 and Windows NT

The 16-bit version of Talk Now! uses an Microsoft multi-media extension "DIB.DRV" which doesn't appear to be supported under Windows NT. This disk contains a 32-bit version of the driver program which attempts to fix this. This is a test version - please report any problems to EuroTalk.

To install the 32-bit version, run the install program. This will prompt for a directory in which to install the new program, the location of the Talk Now! data directory (default x:\Talk-Now\data where x is your CDROM drive), and a program group name. Change these if necessary, then click Ok.

Note the following:

1. If you have CDROM auto-run enabled, it will try to run the old 16-bit version - hold down shift to stop this.
2. If you want to run off a network, you will also need to install the Talk Now! network upgrade.
