Introduction

MacDICT is a DICT client. The DICT protocol lets you access a number of databases available online. MacDICT also accesses the following translation resources located on the web:

BabelFish: <http://babel.altavista.com>

Features

Define(Command-D) lets you look up terms in databases

Match(Command-M) lets you find words that match a certain query

Translate(Command-T) lets you translate words and common phrases into other languages

BabelFish(Command-B) lets you translate entire sentences and paragraphs, but accuracy is greatly reduced.
