

Insight Installation Help

There are essentially two methods for installing Insight software onto your hard drive. Method A will run Insight from the CD, Method B will run Insight from the hard disk. The setup.exe routine will prompt the user to choose a method;

Method A - Simply creates a directory of your choice with a few minor support files needed locally.
(Minimal Drive Space Needed)

Method B - Decompress the files found on the CD to the drive and directory of your choice.
(More Drive Space Needed)

Both methods will create a new Program Group in the Program Manager called Insight for Windows. To run the Insight program, open the Insight for Windows Program Group and double-click on the program icon.

Drives List Box

The installation program will search your system and list all drives available for installation, including network drives. Clicking on the down arrow will display the list of drives and the storage space that is available on each drive. Simply click the left mouse button on the drive you wish to install the program onto. You will receive an error message if the drive selected does not have enough space for the program. The C: drive is the default drive selected.

Directory Entry Field

By using the directory entry field, you may choose a specific directory for Insight's installation, or create a new one. If the directory that you enter into the box does not exist, the installation program will create it.

Aborting The Installation

It is possible to stop the installation by clicking the left mouse button on the Abort command button. If you choose to abort, you will have to re-install Insight before you can use it, unless the program is run directly from the CD.
