Choosing a Registration Method

First, decide how you want to pay. If you have a modem attached to your computer (or inside it), you can register immediately. Choose Immediate On-line Registration. All you need is a credit card.

If you'd rather pay by check, then choose Order by Mail/Fax. With this option, you will print out an order form on paper. You can also fax your order if you want to pay by credit card.

Payment When Ordering by Modem:

Type in information about your credit card. Rest assured that this information is kept confidential. Your account number will not be stored anywhere in your computer.

The expiration date should be in MM/YY format. For example, if your card expires in January of 1996, you should fill in: 1/96.

We currently accept Visa, Mastercard, Discover, and American Express.

Payment When Ordering by Mail or Fax

Choose whether you will pay by check or credit card. If you want to fax your order form, you'll need to use a credit card. Rest assured that your credit card account number will remain secure and will not be stored permanently inside your computer or on your computer's disk drive.

The Customer Information Screen

This data allows us to send you products and information through the mail, and to contact you should a problem arise. Your fax number and e-mail address are optional.

The Additional Purchase Screen

To buy an additional product, highlight the product on the list at the left side of the screen. Then hit Add to Shopping List. Similarly, to remove an item from your list of things to be purchased, highlight the item on the right side of the screen and then hit Remove from Shopping List. You can edit the quantity to purchase and the product type by double-clicking an item in your shopping list.

Comments to the Developer

Type any comments or feedback you have for the developer of this program. These comments get transmitted to the developer along with your payment (or, if you're paying through the mail or fax, your comments will be printed on your order form).

Your comments are optional.

The Summary Screen

This is simply a summary of what you're about to purchase. Make sure you approve of the purchase. When you do, click the right arrow. You can go back and make changes by clicking the left arrow. This will let you move through previous screens.

Modem Setup

The computer is going to use your modem to make a toll-free (within U.S. and Canada) call to the Digital Money Network. Your credit card will be charged for the amount of your purchase. To make an electronic payment, you need to have a modem attached to your computer. If you don't have one, you should return to the very first screen in this series and choose another payment method.

The screen you see here asks you some information about your phone system. Many homes have "Call Waiting," which can interrupt computer communication. If you have Call Waiting, indicate it on this screen so that Digital Money can temporarily turn it off. Call Waiting will return to normal after this telephone call.

If you don't have Call Waiting, or if you're not sure how your phone system is set up, just hit the right arrow and let Digital Money try to figure it out.

Processing a Modem Transaction

As you read this, your computer is transmitting your payment to the Digital Money Network. You will be alerted when the transmission is complete.

The Speak with Operator Screen

If you don't have a modem or don't want to register this program electronically, you can call a toll-free telephone number 24 hours a day and register over the telephone.

If you are calling to register a program, tell the operator your "Personal Code" that appears below. The operator will tell you a secret "Unlocking Code." Enter it and press the right arrow. This program will automatically become a registered copy.

If you've changed your mind and do not want to register over the telephone, hit the Cancel to go back to the beginning.
