

The **Change Now** button will immediately change your wallpaper if clicked.

The **Panic Button** exits WallPaper Maniac and instantly removes the wallpaper. This is very useful for those of you who have those "nasty" wallpapers when someone walks in!

The **Interval Bar** determines how long the next wallpaper change is. Valid ranges are from 1 to 720 minutes. Clicking on the up arrow increases the interval, clicking on the down arrow decreases the interval.

The **Random** check box determines how your wallpaper is selected. If checked, your wallpaper will be chosen randomly from your wallpaper directory. If not checked, your wallpaper will be chosen sequentially from your wallpaper directory.

The **Change On Startup** check box determines whether your wallpaper will be changed when WallPaper Maniac loads. If checked, your wallpaper will change on startup. If not checked, your wallpaper will not change on startup.

The **Tile** check box determines if your wallpaper will be tiled. If checked, your wallpaper will be tiled. If not checked, your wallpaper will not be tiled.

The **Stretch** check box determines if your wallpaper is stretched. If checked, the wallpaper will be stretched to fit your desktop and the tile check box will not be available. If not checked, the wallpaper will not be stretched and the tile check box will be available. This is only available in Windows NT 4.0 or higher.

This displays the current wallpapers complete path and filename.

This button displays the about form.

Minimizes WallPaper Maniac and saves any changes you have made.

By clicking **Apply**, you are acknowledging all changes made without minimizing WallPaper Maniac. All current settings are stored in the system registry so that Wallpaper Maniac will remember its settings when it is reloaded. NOTE: Changes DO NOT take effect unless Apply is clicked. Apply is also disabled until something is changed.

This monitor displays the current wallpaper.

This displays the selected preview file.

Clicking the **Browse** button will open a browse box allowing you to preview a wallpaper anywhere.

This box will always be your windows directory. It contains all of the bmp files in your windows directory. By default, this is the directory used for selecting wallpapers when WallPaper Maniac is installed.

This will select the drive where the BMP files are located.

This is the path to your BMP files. This is where WallPaper Maniac will get its wallpapers from.

Displays the current BMP directory that WallPaper Maniac is using.

This displays the current number of wallpapers in the above directory.

Minimizes WallPaper Maniac without saving any changes you have made.
