

If you need help when you are running the Setup program, click , and then click directly on top of a setting or button.

Type your full name in the Name box.

Type the name of your company or organization in the Organization box.

To change the name or organization, click [Change](#).

To record the CD Key number provided with the product, type the number under CD Key.

Displays the product identification number provided with the product. The product identification number is also located on the Certificate of Authenticity.

To install the application in a location different from the folder displayed under Folder, click Change Folder.

To install the application in a different location, click a folder in the Folders box. To create a new folder, click the location you want in the Folders and Drives boxes, and then type the new folder name at the end of the path in the Path box.

To install the application in a different location, click the folder in the Folders box.

To install the application on a different drive, click the drive in the Drives box.

To install all the files most commonly used to run the application, click Typical.

To install all the files in an application, or to manually select the files you want to install, click Custom.

To install only the minimum number of files needed to run the application, click Minimum.

To install on your computer only those files needed to run the application from the CD-ROM, click Run From CD-ROM.

To install the application in a location different from the folder displayed under Folder, click Change Folder.

To install all items in the Options box, click Select All.

To remove an item from the list of items you want to install, clear the check box next to the name of the item in the Options box.

To install only selected items, select the check boxes next to the name of the items in the Options box, and then click Change Options.

To see additional options for the item selected in the Options box, click Change Option. Change Option is unavailable (grayed) if the item has no additional options.

To install the item selected in the Options box in a different location, click Change Folder. Change Folder is available only for items that can be installed in another location.

To connect to or switch to the network drive to install the application, click Network.

Displays the amount of space needed to install this application next to Space Required, and displays the amount of space currently available in the location where you want to install the application next to Space Available. The required amount of space does not include files that may be removed or replaced during installation.

To create a new program group for the application, type a name in the Program Group box.

To display the application icon in an existing program group, click the group in the Existing Groups box.

To display the amount of space required to install the options you have selected under Required, click a drive in the Drive box. The number under Available is the amount of space currently available on the drive. If there is not enough space available on the drive, the number under Needed is the amount of additional space needed to continue the installation.

To create enough disk space to install the application, reduce the number of options you want to install, or make more space available in the location where you want to install the application. To change the application options you want to install, click Change Options.

To install the application with the selected options, click Install Now.

To install files that will be shared with other applications in a different folder, click Change Folder.

Displays the location of application files that will be shared with other users on a network.

To use the existing server and path, click Continue. To connect network users to shared files at a different location, type the new server and path in the Server and Path boxes, and then click Continue.

To locate shared files by using the server name, click Server Name.

To locate shared files by using the drive letter, click Drive Letter.

To choose a drive letter where shared files will be located, click the letter in the Drive box.

To have users choose whether shared files are located by server name or by drive letter, click User's Choice.

To install and use shared files on a server, click [Server](#).

To install shared files on local hard drives, click Local Hard Drive.

To have users choose whether to store shared files on a server or on their local hard drives, click User's Choice.

To install the application so that it can be run from a server, click Run From Server.

To use the files from a network, click Use Source. These files are stored on a server and will not be copied to your local hard drive.

To use shared files from a server, click Server. This option will save space on the local hard drive, but will decrease performance speed.

To use shared files from your local hard drive, click Local Hard Drive. This option increases performance speed, but uses more space on your local hard drive.

To install all items in the Options box, click Select All.

To install or remove an option, select or clear the check box next to the name of the item.

If you cannot select an item in the Options box because it is unavailable (grayed), the item was previously installed by another application. You cannot reinstall or remove the item.

No help topic is associated with this area. Click  again, and then click directly on top of a setting or button.

To install all items in the Options box, click Select All.
