- **Duplex Printing** - when you are duplex printing large documents you should break it down into batches so should a problem occur you only need to reprint a portion of the whole document.
- **Hide/display toolbar buttons** - use the preferences to hide and display each toolbar button. Either of the toolbar buttons can be hidden, including when viewing PDFs in a web browser. (File > Preferences > Duplex).
- All the settings you choose apart from the page range are retained for the next time you use Duplex.
- **Quick print button settings** - set the postscript level, print in binary and choose whether to shrink to fit the page you are printing. (File > Preferences > Duplex).
- **Level 1 & 2 postscript settings** - "PostScript Level 1 is the standard supported by most applications for producing color separations". (*extract from Guidelines for using Adobe Acrobat 3.0 for production printing.*)
- **Shrink page to fit** - will ensure all information on a page will be resized to fit the paper size being used by your printer.
- **Printer's halftone settings** - "retains halftone screen information, such as frequency, angle, and spot functions, used when outputting to a device that uses halftones" (*extract from Adobe Acrobat Distiller Help*)

Reverse print your pages.

Control the order in which pages your printer prints so that your documents always print in the right order.


Set the batch number of pages you want to print at a time when duplex printing.

Use the preferences to hide and display each toolbar button in certain environments.

Set postscript and general options for your Quick print toolbar button.

Store the settings so they are for the next time you use ARTS Duplex.
