But under Amiga, with a so-easy-to-use environment so drag&drop, with ↵ powerfull MUI GUI, WebMaker should be respect this builder spirit.

All products are registered to their authors.

1.4 Installation

Installation

WebMaker need to work fine :

- textfield.gadget (copy classes/gadgets/textfield.gadget into your sys:classes/gadgets drawer, also avail on aminet dev/gui)
- MUI 3.1+ (if you use 3.0, update in 3.1)
- AmigaOS 3.x+
- images datatypes gif, etc...

Click on icon to start...

WebMaker is looking for its localization, the drawer progdir:catalogs/your_language.

WebMaker need the drawer prodir:images

If you use MagicMenu or/and CycleMenu, You *MUST* install the SafeGIRPort patch, available in textfield archive

1.5 The Way to Use

Using

After running, WebMaker opens an text-edit window. Hit your text and drog icons.

You want set a bit of text in bold, for example. Select the text and click under B gadget, or go to menus.

The main idea is the insert tags into buffer happens where the cursor is. The text style attributes must be done on selected text.

The use is very intuitive.

All cut-copy-paste functions are enabled (A-c A-v A-b A-x)
Erase function (A-e) puts buffer into undo buffer.

For all complete textfield use, please refer to its documentation.
