Uninstall

Uninstall allows you to delete the Screen Scenes files to clear space on your computer.

To Uninstall the program, double-click on the **Uninstall Screen Scenes** icon in the **Disney Interactive** program group.

1. Click on the Start button on the Taskbar, to bring up the Start menu.
2. Select Programs then Disney Interactive from the cascading submenu, click on Screen Scenes.

Wallpaper



A click on Wallpaper takes you to the Wallpaper menu where you can set up your own choice of images and timing.

Screen Saver



A click here opens the Screen Saver menu where you can set up your own choice of images, timing and transition effects.

On/Off



Click on ON to make the Screen Scenes active. Click on OFF to disable the Screen Scenes.

Sound



Click on Sound to enable or disable all Screen Saver interface sound effects.

Help



Click on Help to get help on running the Screen Scenes.

About



Click on About for program credits.

Quit



Click on **Quit** once you have completed all your settings.

Screen Saver and Wallpaper Options

Screen Saver is pre-set to run automatically, but you can set up your own choice of images, how they appear and how often they change.

Setup

Click on Setup to configure when the Screen Saver or wallpaper should start and after how long would you like a displayed image to change.

Images

Click on Images to select the images you would like to display on your computer screen for both wallpaper and Screen Saver features.

Effects

Click on Effects to choose the transition effects leading from one Screen Saver image to the next. Effects are only available for the Screen Saver.

From here you can choose when and how often the selected Screen Saver images change.

Start Screen Saver After

Click on the time scale to set the time (from never to 30 minutes) your mouse or keyboard must remain inactive before the Screen Saver image appears.
If you select never, the Screen Saver feature will be inactive.

Start Energy Saver After

The Energy Saver saves energy by turning your monitor off after a determined time. Click on the time scale to set the time (from 30 to 60 minutes) your mouse or keyboard must remain inactive before the Energy Saver is enabled.

If you select never, the energy saver feature will be inactive.

Note: If this function is not available, your computer is not compatible with Energy Saver.

Change Image Every

Click on the time scale to set the time (from 1s to 5mn.) a Screen Saver image remains on display before changing.

Sound Effects

Click on the **Sound Effects** box to enable/disable all transition sound effects.

Random Images

Click on the Random images box to display the selected Screen Saver images in random order. This does not apply if you have only selected one image.

Random Effects

Click on the Random effects box to display the selected transition effects in random order. This does not apply if you have only selected one transition.

Wallpaper Setup Selection

From here you can choose when and how often the selected Wallpaper images change and various other options.

Change image every Click on the time scale to set the time (from never to every week) a Wallpaper image remains on display before changing.

Random Images

Click on the Random images box to display the selected Wallpaper images in random order. This does not apply if you have only selected one image.

Change at Startup

Click on the Change at Startup box to change the Wallpaper image every time you startup your computer.

Full Screen Image

Click on the Full Screen Image box to display the Wallpaper image full screen.

Image Selection



To scroll through all the images, use the hands pointing left and right.
To select an image click on it. A selected image has a red border.

Select All

Clear All

Select All

Click Select all and all the images will be displayed.

Clear All

Click Clear all to deselect all the images.

Note: if you do not select any images, a black screen will be displayed for both Screen Saver and wallpaper features.

Effect Selection



To scroll through all the effects, use the hands pointing left and right.
To select an effect click on it. A selected transition effect has a red border.

Select All

Clear All

Select All

Click Select all and all the effects will be displayed.

Clear All

Click Clear all to deselect all the effects.

Other Screen Savers

For Window Users, to use Screen Scenes, you must remove all other Screen Savers from the **Startup** program group and restart Windows.

After Dark must be completely removed from the memory since it does not install an icon in the StartUp program group. Turning off After Dark using its Control Panel will still not allow Disney Interactive software to run as the Screen Saver. Follow the procedure in your After Dark documentation to Uninstall the After Dark Screen Saver.
