You know Digital Domain, they're the same people who zorched the opening animation sequence in *MechWarrior 2* and the awesome special effects in *Apollo 13* and *True Lies*.

1. System Requirements

Microsoft Windows 95

486DX/66 MHz (or higher) IBM or 100% compatible PC

8MB RAM

VGA display 640x480 minimum resolution, 256 colors capable

CD-ROM drive (for installation & optional audio effects only)

Sound Blaster-compatible sound card (for optional audio effects)

10 Mb hard disk space

2. Getting Started

To install the Ted Shred Screen Saver:

- Insert the CD-ROM into your CD-ROM drive. Setup should begin automatically.
- If Setup does not begin automatically, click on Start->Run... and type D:\SETUP.EXE in the entry field. Click Ok.
- Reboot your system - this will ensure that Ted Shred is automatically loaded as your default Screen Saver.

To change your default Screen Saver, do the following:

- Right-click on any unused portion of your desktop
- Select **Properties**
- Select the **Screen Saver** tab
- Click on the selection box right below the words Screen Saver
- Ted should be selected as your Screen Saver. You can choose any other Screen Saver here.
- Enter the desired Wait time of non-activity before you want your Screen Saver to begin executing
- Click Ok

3. Options

To access the Ted Shred Screen Saver options, do the following:

- Right-click on any unused portion of your desktop
- Select **Properties**
- Select the **Screen Saver** tab
- Note that Ted should be selected as your Screen Saver
- Press the **Settings** button

The Ted Shred Screen Saver supports several Audio features which can be activated by placing a checkmark.

- Insert an audio CD into your CD ROM drive. If you check **Play Entire CD**, the Screen Saver will automatically start your audio CD as soon as it is activated. If you check **Just play CD Audio track: n**, the Screen Saver will play just one particular track when it is activated.
- Check **Play WAVE Audio Music** if you would like to hear an original soundtrack whenever the Screen Saver is activated.

You can also control the order of the module playback:

- By default, the Screen Saver will play each scene in order. If you check **Play scenes in random order**, the different scenes will be displayed in a random order.
- Check the **Slide Show** box if you would like the Screen Saver to display scenes of Ted Shred artwork in addition to the animated sequences (Note: this box may not be displayed on all versions of the Ted Shred Screen Saver).

Press OK to confirm your new settings. The Ted Shred Screen Saver can be launched immediately by pressing the **Preview** button.

4. Technical Notes

- This Screen Saver is supported on **Windows 95** only. It does not run properly on Windows 3.1.
- While Ted Shred Screen Saver supports all display modes, it runs best in a 640x480x256 configuration.
- Ted Shred Screen Saver will take advantage of DirectX, if it has been installed on your system, to automatically effect mode changes to 640x480x256 whenever the Screen Saver is executed. If DirectX has not been installed, the Screen Saver will execute at the resolution that your display is currently configured to - the resulting images and bitmaps may be smaller than desired.
