

Convolver Star Hints

KPT Convolver contains an on-board award system: As you become more experienced with the software and demonstrate proficiency, the Convolver gradually provides you with new tools. It actually pays to become a Power User! Each time a new feature is awarded, a new star will appear at the top of the Convolver interface, and you will be instructed on how to use your new tool.

This can be fun and invigorating; however, for those who like to jump right into the fire, we have provided some hints that may help to speed up this process. If you absolutely must know the shortest route from point A to point B, check out the hints below. Each hint contains items which lead to more hints. Simply click on any star you find below to begin.

Among the enhancements you will be awarded is a way to save presets into what we call Dot Files (you'll see why...). Once you have received this feature (Star 4), you will be able to use the sample Dot Files contained here.

It is important to understand that presets, in the context of Convolver, are not quite the same as presets in the way we generally understand them. That's because a certain effect created by Convolver will look exactly as you like when applied to the image for which it was created, but it will most likely have a completely different effect when applied to a different image. Therefore, storing presets in the traditional sense will be of little value.

The Dot Files, however, enable you to save settings designed for specific images, and to store them remotely along with the image files. Convolver contains several on-board images for exploration purposes; the Dot Files contained in this folder are tweaked specifically for each of these images. If you have been awarded the Memory Dots feature, just open Convolver, select an image from the Options Menu; Hand Lines, for instance; then select Load Dots from the same Options Menu, and load HAND.DOT. Click on each dot to see custom settings created specifically for that image. We encourage you to explore each on-board image and its corresponding Dot File in this way.
