1.2 Catalogo Italiano di ReOrg

Requisiti:

Sono necessari:

- Amiga con sistema operativo 2.1 o superiore
- ReOrg versione 3.11

Installazione:

Purtroppo (causa pigrizia) non ho scritto un programma per l'ottimo Installer della Commodore. Comunque non dovrebbe essere affatto difficile installare questo catalogo; ma, se ci dovessero essere problemi, posso cercare di spiegarvi:

- 1 - aprire una shell (quella finestra dove si può comunicare con Amiga imparando comandi con la tastiera)
- 2 - modificare la directory corrente in quella che contiene il nuovo catalogo fornito; se, per esempio, l'archivio è stato scompattato in 'RAM:', si dovrebbe digitare:
Cd RAM:ReOrg3.1/Catalogs/Italiano
- 3 - copiare il catalogo nella directory dei cataloghi; per esempio si potrebbe digitare:
Copy ReOrg.catalog LOCALE:Italiano

Ricordate che si può memorizzare il catalog assieme al programma ReOrg,

avendo cura di copiarlo nella sottodirectory 'Catalogs/Italiano'.

Un po di polemica

1.3 ReOrg Italian Catalog

Requirements:

You will need:

- an AmigaOS 2.1+
- ReOrg v3.11

Installation:

I'm sorry. I did not write an Installer script (and I won't ever: I am too lazy). However I think you will be able to install this you by yourself, but if you are not I will explain:

- 1 - open a shell
- 2 - change the current path to the directory containing the catalog; for example, if you have unpacked to 'RAM:', you should type
Cd RAM:ReOrg3.1/Catalogs/Italiano
- 3 - copy the catalog to your catalogs' directory; for example you could type:
Copy ReOrg.catalog LOCALE:Italiano

Remember that it is possible to store this catalog in the directory that contains ReOrg, if you store it in the subdirectory 'Catalogs/Italiano'.

More Over:

This archive contains the Italian catalog that I've build and I use with this powerful program. I'm VERY disappointed that, even if this one does support localization, the shareware package (that you could upload from Aminet, for example) hasn't got neither a .cd file (i.e. a Catalog Descriptor) nor a .ct file (i.e. a Catalog Translation). This way it is fairly difficult for the average user (i.e. me and, maybe, you) to build his own .catalog. I've been forced to translate the German catalog (... the English one doesn't exist: it is built in :-). Unfortunately I don't know German too much (well, I've heard something like "ai, svai, polizai", but I think it won't suffice :-). It was a very hard task looking at the german catalog, while looking at the HEX (and ASCII) display of AZap v2.40 (thank you Denis Gounelle for writing this one), and testing with ReOrg !

Now I'm pretty sure it works and it works fine. I promise I will fix every bug (better to be named 'bad translation') you will find (obviously you are supposed to send a bug report to me). However I hope that the catalog will be ok for you (... if you are Italian, and you use Italian catalogs).
