1.6 A64 Package V3.0 demo

Feature: A64 Package V3.0 demo by Questronix

A fully-functional but time-limited version of the best 64 emulator on the Amiga. Definitely worth a shot, as it's considerably better than its predecessors.

1.7 GuidePrefs 1.0

1. AmigaGuide Writer 1.02 by David McPaul

Not a "writer" in the true sense of the word, but a utility that allows text files to be Amiga-Guided with ease and/or power (depending on the way you like to do this sort of thing.)

1.8 ITF V1.55

2. ITF V1.55 by InfoTaskForce and David Kinder

An incredibly great program if you like Infocom games. This interpreter will allow you to play any Infocom game written in version 1-5 of the Z-Code format (including everything but the graphic games, such as Arthur or Shogun. Beyond Zork DOES work, however). There are even new games being written for this format. One game, the original Adventure, is included. Bear in mind that this program effectively allows Amiga users access to the entire (budget-compiled) Infocom collection. Volume 2 was never released for Amigans, but since this program reads the data files, as long as you have CrossDOS, you can have the games.

1.9 UUxT 3.0

3. UUxT 3.0 by Asher Feldman

Feldman knows uuencoding and decoding. This is a package with both CLI and GUI versions, allowing easy translation of uu format files. The encoder of choice for Amiga Report.

1.10 NoReboot

4. NoReboot CD32 by Stuart MacKinnon

A short, simple program (with short, simple source) that allows a CD32 lid to be opened without resetting the machine. Invaluable for anybody using a CD32 as more than a game console.
