Requirements

Panther (Mac OS X 10.3) for the installer, Jaguar (Mac OS X 10.2) otherwise (for manual installation)

Microsoft Entourage (configured for the installing user)

Installation

To install, simply run the *Install* AppleScript provided with this disk image.

What the Installer does

The installer creates a new top level folder named "Junk" within Entourage's E-Mail window.

It also copies the three AppleScripts to Entourage's Script Menu Items folder.

Finally, it copies the Application Bundle to your /Applications folder.

(Previous copies of those files will be overwritten.)

If you've been running an older version of JunkBroom

Please update your filter rule in Entourage! The name of the filter script has changed from "Junk Filter" to "JunkBroom - Filter" to avoid confusion.

Quick Start Guide

After you've run *Install*, you can use JunkBroom's dock menu icon entries:

- "Mark as Good" adds the selected messages to the "good" database.
- "Mark as Junk" adds the selected messages to the "bad" database.

To filter messages using the learned data, add a rule to the end of your Entourage rule set that applies to *all messages* and runs *the "JunkBroom - Filter" AppleScript*.

Alternatively you can use the new entries in Entourage's script menu (at the end of Entourage's menu entries, right next to the "Help" menu):

- "Mark as Junk" adds emails to the "bad" database.
- "Mark as Good" adds emails to the "good" database.

Another way to achieve these actions is through the "Filter" menu of JunkBroom. Alternatively, there is a global menu that makes the core functionality of JunkBroom available from the system menu bar.
