### **SYSTEM REQUIREMENTS**

To run Absolute Time Corrector 3.0, your system must meet the following minimum requirements:

- A 486 with a 66 MHz processor (Pentium processor recommended)
- For Microsoft Windows 95: 8 MB of RAM minimum
- For Microsoft Windows NT: 16 MB of RAM minimum
- For Microsoft Windows NT: It is recommended to run Service Pack 3 (or higher)
- 1500 KB of hard-disk space
- High Color Video Mode
- Mouse

### **SETUP**

**Important!** If you've got Absolute Time Corrector not from our web page, but from the other source (magazine CD or some software library), please visit our home page - you'll probably find the later version; usually, we release the updates about once a month.

To install Absolute Time Corrector, just run the "atcXX.exe" and follow the instructions. You'll need to select the target directory and the components to install.

### **UNINSTALLING Absolute Time Corrector 3.0**

You can uninstall Absolute Time Corrector 3.0 by carrying out the following steps:

1. In Control Panel, double-click the Add/Remove Programs icon.
2. Click Absolute Time Corrector, and then click Add/Remove.
3. Follow the instructions on your screen.
