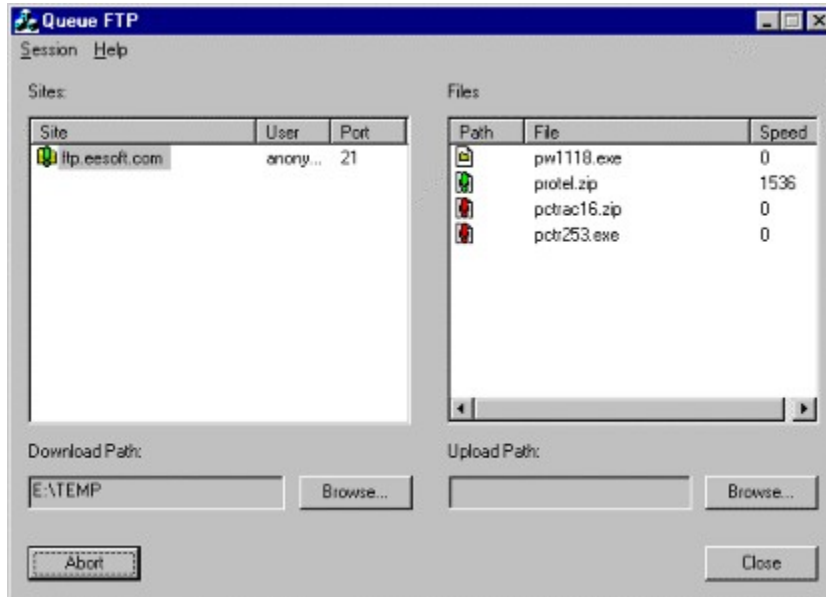


Queue FTP Help Index

Queue FTP is an application to allow batch ftp and web downloads. Its use involves dragging links from web pages onto the main window. Once the links are dragged (or even during dragging), the “Go” button is pressed to begin downloads. Queue FTP will continue trying to download all the files until all are either retrieved or determined to not exist.

DESCRIPTION OF MAIN WINDOW



The main windows consists of:

Site List: This area lists all the sites scheduled for download. The graphic image to the left of the site provides status of the connection.

- Not connecting to site.
- Connecting to site.
- Downloading from site.
- Site is probably a ratio site.
- Site or account is probably no longer valid.

File List: This area lists the files for the currently selected site (see site list). The graphic image to the left of the file provides status of the file.

- Not trying this file.
- Attempting to download this file.
- File download in progress.

Download Path: This path is where the downloaded files where be stored. Select the browse button to change this path.

Upload Path: This path is where uploads are taken from. This is currently unused. In the future, uploading for ratio sites may be available.

Go/Abort: This button starts or stops the batch transfer process.

Session-Options: Specific options for downloading are available here.
