

Millennium Bug Toolkit for Networks 3.6N

Quick Start Guide

This document describes how to get started with the Millennium Bug Toolkit for Networks 3.6N. See the manual stored on the CD-ROM for more information.

The CD-ROM

The software contained on this CD is designed to run on Windows 95 or above, or Windows NT 4.0 or above. The CD-ROM contains the following:

- The “RTC See” demonstration,
- Release Notes,
- The Millennium Bug Toolkit for Networks 3.6N manual, and
- The Millennium Bug Toolkit for Networks 3.6N setup program

The AutoRun

This CD-ROM is autorun enabled. This means that when you put the CD in your drive you will automatically get the main menu of the CD. If you have disabled autorun on your computer then execute “autorun.exe” on the CD-ROM.

“RTC See”

RTC See is a simple application that displays the time stored in your real-time clock and the system clock. To create an “RTC See” disk, choose the appropriate option from the menu. The resulting disk can be used on PCs running Windows 9x or DOS. To use the disk, restart your PC in MS-DOS mode and execute “a:\rtcsee”.

Release Notes

These provide last-minute notes pertaining to the current release.

The Manual

It is recommended that you carefully read the entire manual before attempting to install the software. If you have got Office 97, then there is a version in Word 97 format in the directory “D:\DOCS\MANUAL97.DOC” (where ‘D’ is your CD Drive).

The Setup Program

This is the program that installs the MBTK for Networks on your ‘collation machine’. If you do not know which machine you want to be the collation machine, then please see the manual for more information.
