

## **GoCD v1.02 Release Notes**

Thanks for downloading GoCD, a program to simplify the launching of CDROM applications under Microsoft Windows.

**\*\* STOP PRESS \*\***

GoCD 1.02 provides support for working directories. These are not documented in the help file, but their use should be self-explanatory. Also, the GoCD editor mentioned in the help file has been completed and is included in this archive.

### **Archive contents**

You should find the following files in the archive:

GOCD.EXE	The main executable
GOCDEDIT.EXE	GoCD database editor
GOCD.HLP	The help file
GOCD.WRI	I reckon you'll have this as well (you're reading it!)
CTL3D.DLL	3D dialog DLL, version 2.08 (the latest at the time of writing)
SETUP.EXE	Setup file
SETUP.INF	Setup information file

### **Installation**

There are two ways to install GoCD:

#### **1. The easy way**

Execute SETUP, by selecting File|Run from the Program Manager menu and typing c:\temp\setup (assuming you have unzipped the archive into your \temp directory -if not, substitute the correct path as appropriate). This will copy the required files to a directory of your choice, and put CTL3D.DLL into \windows\system if you don't already have it, or have an earlier version, then create a Program Manager icon for GoCD.EXE

#### **2. The (slightly) harder way**

Simply put \*.EXE, GOCD.HLP into any directory you choose, and put CTL3D.DLL into your windows system directory if you don't already have it. GoCD is not fussy about CTL3D.DLL version - it should work with any, so there is no need to overwrite your existing copy if you are unsure which is the later version.

### **Running GoCD**

The first time you click on the GoCD icon, you'll be asked to enter the drive letter of your CDROM drive. This will be remembered for future sessions.

Subsequently, GoCD will look at your CDROM drive for a disc. If it finds one it will search through its list of 'registered' discs. If it has encountered the disc before, the program on the CD will be executed immediately.

If it is a new disc, it will need to be 'registered' with GoCD. This involves typing the name of the program and the command to be executed to start the CD software. If you are unsure what to type here, press the Help button.

## **Design philosophy**

The program has been designed to be easy to use and as unobtrusive as possible. Consequently you'll find no bells and whistles. Just a small, efficient utility. I hope you appreciate this!

## **Registration**

GoCD is cheap, but quality Shareware. Single licences are just US\$10 or £5. To register, print out the form in the help file and mail to me at the address below, or use CompuServe's SWREG system GoCDs ID is 3116. See the help file for registration benefits.
