MEG reports space in Megabytes which is slightly more
than a million bytes. One MEG or MB = **1,048,576 bytes**.

A confusing thing to explain is that almost all hard disk drive makers advertise in round millions of bytes. This is really false advertising and was most likely a marketing decision but that is why MEG shows numbers lower than you may have thought (or it said on the box). Your drives capacity in Mb is normally about 5% less than they claimed when you bought it.

You can see this for yourself by using FDISK display option from DOS to display your hard drives formatted capacity if you want to verify this.

Total space, Free space, and Percent used are shown by MEG.
A large pie graph and 3-D bar graphs show your space.

CPU type and Extended memory are displayed, CPUs up to the Pentium are supported. An instruction timing test is done on the processor in an attempt to get speed in megahertz. A smaller pie graph is used to display lower memory.

The main display is big so that it will be legible on laptops.

If a mouse driver is loaded you can scan your drives by manual mouse control. Drives can also be autoscanned or switched by entering the next drive letter.

COMMAND FORMAT:

MEG drivechar optionchar

where: drivechar is a character from A-Z

optionchar is character S or B (scan or bios)

Example1 - MEG C (Graph the C drive)

Example2 - MEG D S (Graph the D drive then scan all)

Example3 - MEG A B (Graph A drive use slower bios
graphics instead of default direct memory graphics)

MEG will skip floppy drives with no diskettes and CD-ROM drives although it will identify CD-ROMs.

Windows Installation Instructions

1. Run INSTALL.EXE from the directory or floppy which you unzipped MEG.

Example from File Manager: Select RUN and enter A:INSTALL or the correct path name of the INSTALL.EXE. Or double click on the file name INSTALL.

Using MEG

MEG defaults to the current drive, to switch to another drive enter the letter: A,C,D, etc., which represents the new drive you wish to graph. Hit any keyboard key to exit. After about one minute a series of 5 screen savers will begin. Lower memory and Disk space are graphed. Your CPU is speed tested each time you switch drives.

Registered users receive extra utilities, support, a newer version on disk and lots more documentation, plus a configuration option which will let you customize MEG. All the shareware messages will be turned off, you get upgrade notices and can upgrade either free or very cheaply.

You also get a registered copy of WinBag a full featured calendar and utility program which has a 5 language calendar a game and graphs disk space and windows resources. This is also sold seperately for \$20.

With the mouse, you can advance by clicking the left button, or exit with the right button. You can start autoscan by mouse clicking in the upper left corner of the screen.

If the mouse cursor is not visible you need to load a mouse driver. This is normally done by the MOUSE command from DOS or your Autoexec.Bat.

Ordering the Full Version

DEFINITION OF SHAREWARE

Shareware distribution gives users a chance to try software before buying it. If you try a Shareware program and continue using it, you are expected to register. Individual programs differ on details -- some request registration while others require it, some specify a maximum trial period. With registration, you get anything from the simple right to continue using the software to an updated program with printed manual.

Shareware is a distribution method, not a type of software. You should find software that suits your needs and pocketbook, whether it's commercial or Shareware. The Shareware system makes fitting your needs easier, because you can try before you buy. And because the overhead is low, prices are low also. Shareware has the ultimate money-back guarantee -- if you don't use the product, you don't pay for it.

Users of MEG must accept this disclaimer of warranty: MEG software program is supplied as is. The author disclaims all warranties, expressed or implied, including, without limitation, the warranties of merchantability and of fitness for any purpose. The author assumes no liability for damages, direct or consequential, which may result from the use of MEG.

MEG is a "shareware program" and is provided at no charge to the user for evaluation. Feel free to share it with your friends, but please do not give it away altered or as part of another system. The essence of "user-supported" software is to provide personal computer users with quality software without

high prices, and yet to provide incentive for programmers to

continue to develop new products. If you find this program useful and find that you are using MEG and continue to use MEG after a reasonable trial period, you must make a registration payment of \$20 to James Tolliver.
