


Letter People Sounds and Clues

As an aid to the child's identification of the sounds of the alphabet, each Letter Person has been given both a visual clue in the form of a symbol that illustrates a key feature of the character and a sound clue in the form of a key word or words. Each visual clue has been designed to trigger the child's recollection of a specific sound clue. Each sound clue has been carefully chosen to suggest to the child the sound of a specific letter of the alphabet. The following is a listing, in alphabetical order, of the visual clue and sound clue that has been given to each Letter Person.
