Sub Whatever()

Encrypt

Sub Whatever()

'instanciate UnOmissions object

Dim sResult as String

'string is encrypted

sResult = oUO.Encrypt("String to encrypt", "Key for encrypting")

'pass encrypted string back to function with same key for decrypting

sResult = oUO.Encrypt(sResult, "Key for encrypting")

Sub Whatever()

Sub Whatever()

Dim oUO as New UnOmissions

'program execution stops for 3.257 seconds

oUO.Pause 3257

Set oUO = Nothing

End Sub

Replace

Sub Whatever()

'instantiate UnOmissions object

Dim oUO as New UnOmissions

Dim sResult as String

'sResult receives the string "aXcaXcaXc"

sResult = oUO.Replace("abcabcabc", "b", "X", False)

Set oUO = Nothing

End Sub

Round

Sub Whatever()

'instanciate UnOmissions object

Dim oUO as New UnOmissions

Dim dResult as Double

'dResult receives 100.1235

dResult = oUO.Round(100.12345, 4)

Set oUO = Nothing

End Sub

StrField

Sub Whatever()

'instantiate UnOmissions object

'sResult receives "field3"

sResult = oUO.StrField("field1,field2,field3,field4", 3, ",")

Timer

Sub Whatever()

'turn on "stop watch"

IResult = oUO.Timer(True)

'do some stuff here

'IResult receives number of milliseconds

'expired since "stop watch" was turned on

IResult = oUO.Timer(False)

MakeTransparent

Sub Whatever()

'instanciate UnOmissions object

Dim oUO as New UnOmissions

*'frmWhatever is the name of a form that contains the PictureBox
'named picWhatever. Whatever color you set in the BackColor
'property of picWhatever is the color that will be made transparent
'in the image contained in the Picture property of picWhatever.*

oUO.MakeTransparent frmWhatever, frmWhatever.picWhatever

Set oUO = Nothing

End Sub

ListHorzScroll

Sub Whatever()

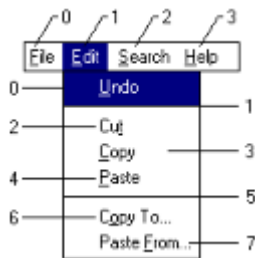

This sample code would affect the "Copy" menu item in the figure below. picChecked is the name of the picture control that contains the image that will be placed to the left of the menu item when that menu item is in a "checked" state. picUnchecked is the name of the picture control that contains the image for the "unchecked" state.

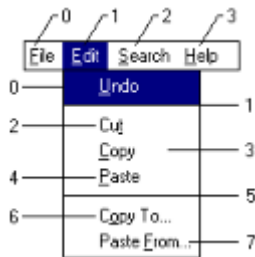
