

Multiple Cabinets

WinCAB can put the data in multiple cabinets, so you can easily copy them on a disc. Following cabinet sizes are supported: 720K, 1.44K, ZIP Disks 100M and Flyer Disks 230M.

Compression

WinCAB can make archive with or without compression. The compression types supported are listed below:

<u>Name</u>	<u>Compression</u>	<u>Compression Speed</u>	<u>Description</u>
<i>MSZIP</i>	Medium	High	similar to PKWARE's ZIP
<i>LZX</i>	High	Low	LZX compression

Is WinCAB free?

No, WinCAB is shareware. That means that you're allowed to use WinCAB for 30 days, and if you want to keep using it after those 30 days, you should register. Registration is only \$5, and is valid for all future versions of WinCAB.
