1. INSTALLING THE SOFTWARE AND LOGGING ON

-

Before you install the software, please check the following.....

Make sure that YOUR Windows can communicate with YOUR modem.

(You can do this by using the Windows Terminal Application supplied by Windows.)

Make a note of YOUR modem settings.

Make a note of YOUR port settings.

Ensure that no other TCP/IP packages are loaded on your machine, including other versions or instances of Chameleon. (If you have had other TCPIP packages loaded, please ensure that ALL references to them have been removed from both your WIN.INI file and your SYSTEM.INI file in your WINDOWS directory, and from your AUTOEXEC.BAT and CONFIG.SYS.)

Installation

Installation is simple ... put the Sampler Disk in Drive A and from within Windows select **Run** from the **File** menu and type **A:\setup**. The setup program will warn you about other networking software. This sampler is SERIAL LINE ONLY, and should not interfere with a network. By default the software installs in **c:\netmanag** (you may change this if you wish), then it will complete the installation..

Please see the PCPlus Magazine for details of how to configure this Sampler to connect you to your FREE connection to SERVELAN.

2. WHAT IS SUPPORTED ... AND WHAT ISN'T

Leaf are delighted to be working with PCPlus magazine to bring you the Sampler version of NetManage's Chameleon software and the opportunity of a month's free access to the Internet via our own SERVELAN Internet Service.

The Sampler

The version of Chameleon in this sampler is VERSION 3.11. It does not by any means contain the number of applications available in the latest version, Version 4.5, which are listed below.

Included in Chameleon Sampler is FTP, a file transfer protocol, which will enable you to download remote files to your local hard drive. PING, a Packet Internet Groper, is the most basic and useful Internet testing tool available. TELNET lets you log in to remote computers on the Internet and emulates various terminals. It supports ANSI (not bulletin boards), VT52, VT100 and VT220 terminal emulation, with easy drag and drop keyboard remapping.

There are no News Group or email applications ... can you imagine where all those homeless incoming email messages would go after the end of the months' access?

Leaf supplies the Sampler as shareware, making no warranties for it and accepting no responsibility for its performance or effect upon ANY system. Having said that, you will find the product to be a fast and reliable method of connecting to the Internet.

Leaf does **NOT** offer support for the Sampler ... NEITHER, for the purposes of this free offer, can we recommend nor support ANY Web Browsers, although Chameleon will operate with NetScape or Mosaic. A list of sites from where NetScape can be obtained is incorporated in this readme for your convenience.

Our Support

De-installation

Should you wish to DE-INSTALL Chameleon Sampler, then remove the c:\netmanag directory (or wherever you specified at the install time.)

Delete the servelan sampler group icon.

Edit your c:\windows\win.ini, and remove the TCPIP section. See example below.

[TCPIP]

ID=P37GW5MR1BqF4ILFSIix

SLIP=C:\NETMANAG\SLIP.INI

FILE=C:\NETMANAG\TCPIP.CFG
