[Click here](#) to select a logon profile that will be used every time when you access Outlook personal folders.

Click [here](#) to use the default Microsoft Outlook logon profile to access Outlook personal folders when importing or exporting notes.

Click [here](#) to choose Microsoft Outlook synchronization folder for HPC Notes. By default HPC Notes synchronizes with the default **Notes** folder. You may select any other Outlook folder, such as **another notes folder** or **Inbox folder**. If you change the synchronization folder while the mobile device is connected to the desktop PC, Windows CE synchronization services will be automatically restarted. You may be prompted then for the method of synchronization.

Click [here](#) to synchronize protected notes. You may specify a up to 3 different passwords. Only notes that match one of these passwords will be synchronized. Protected notes that do not match any of these passwords will be skipped. If this option is not selected all the protected notes will be skipped during synchronization.

Click this button to re-synchronize all items, including notes, contacts, files, etc. If your mobile device is not connected or ActiveSync synchronization manager is not running, an error message will be displayed.
