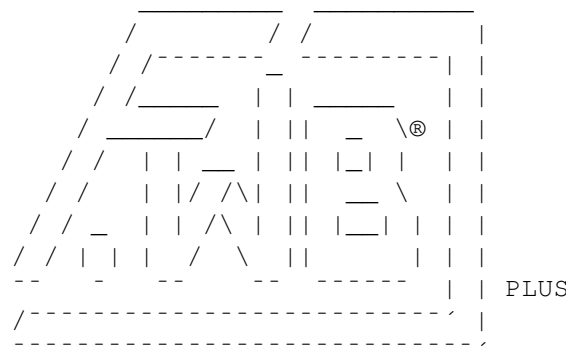

1.4 descript

1. Short description of FANTASTIC.WB+

- This package contains all standart System-Icons and more (e.g. Icons from Release I & II). They are painted in a new completely different

style: They look now very 3-dimensional, some have 16 colors, have my brown gradient filling (RES-Style), feature a click and push animation if being clicked onto to simulate a (real) pushed button.

If you are not convinced to use this package, please take a look at the preview picture by double-clicking the Icon with "camera" view.

2. Motivation of making FANTASTIC.WB+

Version I:

I didn't like sometimes the grey gradient fills on the MagicWB Icontemplates. I think there must be a way to make the Icons nicer on my system. I look at some other Archives and found some Hints. But these Hints are not that what I want. I draw a new gradient -> the lightbrown gradient (RES-Style) and then the 4-point edgcorners. In the first Version I use a grey gradient background on the Icons. They look very nice with the ugly Commodore frame.

Version II:

A friend of me (R.Patzner) gives me some Patches like: IconNoFill & IconNoDraw* and a new idea of a Icontemplate which shows a real Button effect. Now I have my old Icons without the Commodore frame and I mine, the looks very strange and that's not possible to stay longer, I modified Roman's Template a little bit and mix them up with my old RES-Templates

- the result's of this mixture is this package Ver\$:2

3. System Requirements

To use this archive (with all features) you need:

- min. Kickstart 2.x
- a Screenmode with 16 colors and also proportional resolution (e.g. 800*600; 640x512 this are resolution with square pixels).
- And you should have a harddisk if you want to install the whole package. Make sure that you have 1.58 MB of free disk space on this harddisk.

Background Informations (Features) of RES-Icons

- All Icons are painted in a special design-style called 'RES'.
This Style features very plastic/3-D Icons
- Furthermore this Template-Style have a 4-point edgecorner on it.
This definition stays for softer edges (on the black/white edges).
- the Icons have a new Template-style (RES-Template) with a single lightbrown gradient fills.
- all Icons have the greatest possible detail-level due to manual 'pixel by pixel' anti-aliasing.
- Icons are not abstract symbols representing their function, they appear photorealistic. It mines you look at the symbol on the Icons and you know what the Program does.
- Some Icons have a 'cut-n-paste' artwork to stay compatibly with other MagicWB-Collections. (they are only redrawn with 16 Colors)

AMINET (Utils/wb).

shitty NI-Icons WB, because they looks really better with the ugly Commodore ↔
Frames!.

Follow the next steps to install the right colour....

Steps to install them on your system:

1. Change your screenmode to 16 colors.
2. Load the User-Startup into your editor and change the MagicWB-Daemon to:
Run >NIL: C:MagicWB-Demon 4,123,123,123 5,175,175,175 6,170,144,124 ↔
7,255,169,151 8,80,80,80 9,40,62,91 10,96,128,96 11,226,209,119
3. Do the same with your Startup-Sequence

4. Load Prefs/Palette and change the last four colors to 255,212,203;
122,96,72; 210,210,210; 229,93,93

You have the ROM-Color always installed but the Color 9 isn't right?

Truely you will have the false color n°'s "8 & 9".

Now change the color 8 (0,0,255) to 80,80,80 and the color 9 (50,50,50) to ↵
40,62,91

Do this changes at your two scripts "Startup- and User-Sequence".

Oups If you're a User of MagicCopper (etc.) you have to notice this:

The old Copper n° 8 is now required from the IconTemplate. If you want to use this Coppertools continuously following the next Lines:

1. change the Tooltype-Item on the Coppertool (COLORNUMBER=x)
"x" stays here for the Colour witch the Copper needs to place
his routine.
If you're a User of a 16 ColourWB take the Yellow Colour for "x"
2. create a new Patterns with the "x" Colour and save it.
3. reload the WBPatterns Preference and change the Pattern.
4. after Reloading the Coppertool, everything will be ok.

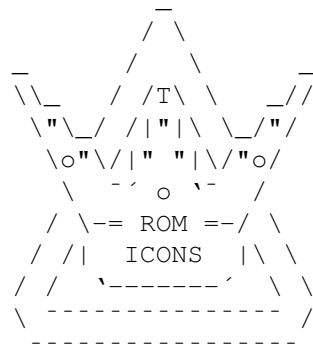
