

~~A Word for Windows Grammatik Grammar Checking Macro~~

Attached to this document is a macro that should help out all you Grammatik(tm) users. It does the following:

- Saves the current document in a form usable by Gmtk.
- Activates the checker with the WFW document
- When Gmtk is terminated, returns to WFW and reloads the edited document in the ready state for more WFW action.

Obviously, such an integration between Word for Windows and Grammatik would be better with DDE but these things will come with time. Currently, Grammatik does not support DDE, but conceptually, all Grammatik checking could be done with an elaborate two way DDE messaging and data passing between Word for Windows and Grammatik.

To install the new attached macro just double click on the install button at the beginning of this document. I would suggest saving your NORMAL.DOT template under a different name before doing this as a backup precaution.

I would suggest using the AssignToKey macro to assign this macro to Ctl-G (or a key of your choosing). That way all you need do to check a WFW document is type one keystroke.
