File Menu

Open

Opens image file.

Save As

Allows image to be saved as a supported format and to a specified location.

Close

Clears the current image from the screen.

Print

Print Setup

Runs the Windows printer setup dialogue box .

Exit

Exits 20/20.

Edit

Copy

Copies current image to the Windows clipboard as a DIB (Device Independent Bitmap).

Paste

Pastes DIB (Device Independent Bitmap) or BMP from the Windows clipboard to the image area.

Mirror Image

Horizontally

Mirrors image horizontally

Vertically

Mirrors image vertically

Rotate Image

90 Degrees, 180 Degrees, 270 Degrees

Rotates image 90, 180, or 270 degrees clockwise from current position.

Invert Colors

Inverts image colors. (Makes the image a negative)

Dither Method

Bayer, Burkes, Floyd-Steinberg

Specifies which dithering algorithm should be used when reducing image colors. You may manually use the following dithering methods in conjunction with the Reduce Colors option

Reduce Colors to

Black/White (2 bit)

256 Grays (8bit Gray)

16 Colors (4 Bits)

256 Colors (8 Bits)

Automatic Color Reduction

20-20 automatically detects the number of colors in your Windows color palette. Using the Burkes dither method, 20/20 reduces the image colors to match the color capability of your Windows video driver. This option is automatically enabled on 256 or less color displays.

Lighten/Darken Image [F11] / [F12]

Lightens or darkens the image to your satisfaction, use this feature instead of adjusting the controls on your monitor.

Magnifies the image to the various percentages.

Reduce Image to Screen

Reduces image's size to best fit the screen.

Slide Show

Select Images...

Start Show [F8]

Starts the slide show for both auto and manual advance. Works with tool bar hidden.

Stop Show [F9]

Stops the slide show. Double clicking on the screen will also stop the slide show. Works with tool bar hidden.

Load Slide Show...

Loads a previously saved slide show.

Save Slide Show...

Saves the slide show to be used later. The current preferences are also saved in the slide show file.

Menu

Hide Menu, Show Menu

Hides or shows the 20/20 menu bar. This allows the image to be viewed on the screen without anything else showing. This feature is only enabled when an image is displayed on the screen.

Preferences

Continuous Slide Show

Indefinitely repeats the slide show.

Auto Resize Large Images

When checked, the image will be automatically resized to fit in the screen during a slide show. Smaller images will not be increased in size.

Mouse Click to Advance

When checked, a single mouse click on the current image will advance the slide show to the next image. Clicking quickly multiple times will advance pictures according to the number of clicks without viewing them.

Setting the Timer

Sets the time between photos in the slide show. Default value is five seconds. There may be longer delays than the entered time if source drive is slow. (i.e. single speed CD-ROM). Maximum auto advance delay is 60 seconds.

Select Pictures for Slide Show

Add Picture(s)

Adds the highlighted images to slide show.

Add All

Adds all images to slide show.

Remove Picture(s)

Removes selected images from the slide show.

Clear All

Removes ALL images from the slide show.

Print Image

Image Size

Tells you the size of the image.

Paper Size

Tells you the printable area based on your printer.

Cancel

Cancels print.

Print

Prints image according to selected options.

Scale Options

Scale

Prints image to the scale you select.

Fit to Page

Prints image to the largest possible size, based on your printer.

Don't Scale

Prints image at true size

Additional notes about printing:

Most images have a maximum of 1024 pixels (dots) and the printer resolution varies from 120 - 360 dots-per-inch for dot matrix and ink jet and 300 - 600 dpi for laser printers. Therefore, images will print very small if printed at the default setting (100%). To fit the image to the page, choose the radio button FIT TO PAGE. You may wish to experiment with the SCALE option to vary the size of the final print.
