

UniFrame ActiveX control

A **UniFrame** control provides an identifiable grouping for controls. You can also use a **UniFrame** to subdivide a form functionally—for example, to separate groups of **OptionButton** controls. Besides **UniFrame** create great looking frames.

Remarks

To group controls, first draw the **UniFrame** control, and then draw the controls inside the Frame. This enables you to move the **UniFrame** and the controls it contains together. If you draw a control outside the **UniFrame** and then try to move it inside, the control will be on top of the **UniFrame** and you'll have to move the **UniFrame** and controls separately.

UniFrame is alignable and can be used in MDI forms

To select multiple controls in a **UniFrame**, hold down the CTRL key while using the mouse to draw a box around the controls.

To set **UniFrame** properties use control's Property Pages.

UniFrame supports standard Visual Basic 5.0 set of events

Shown below is a list of the properties used to manage the UniScale control

Property	Specifies
xType	Returns or sets UniFrame mode: 0 - Simple frame 1 - Double frame 2 - 3D frame 3 - Light button 4 - Pressed light button 5 - Button 6 - Pressed button 7 - 3D down frame 8 - 3D up frame 9 - 3D frame 1 10- 3D frame 2
xDistance	Returns or sets distance between outer and inner frames in twips. 49 < xDistance < 301. Default - 100
xAligntext	Returns or sets text alignment on Uniframe border 0 -- (None) no text displayed 1 - Top left 2 - Top right 3 - Top center 4 - Bottom left 5 - Bottom right 6 - Bottom center
xTransparent	Returns or sets UniFrame to opaque or transparent mode 0 - Transparent 1 - Opaque
Caption	Returns or sets the text displayed on UniFrame border
Picture	Returns or sets the picture displayed inside UniFrame inner frame
BackColor	Returns or sets the background color of an object.
Other properties	Returns or sets values of standard Visual Basic 5.0 properties

The registered version of UniFrame will run in both the runtime and development Visual Basic 5.0 environments.
The shareware version of UniFrame runs only in the development environment.
