Please read the section relevant to your programming language.

Visual Basic

First you should add the addzip???.bas file to your project (where ?? is either 16 or 32). Next add the following lines to the Load event of your main (parent) form (where applicable).

Dim I as Integer
```

I = addZIP_SetParentWindowHandle(Me.hWnd)
```

```
I = addUNZIP_SetParentWindowHandle(Me.hWnd)
```

Users may wish to test the return value of these function calls in case there is a problem with setting the Windows handle (this will probably never occur, but you never know). See the function definitions for the reasoning behind these functions.

First of all you must register. Without registering you will only be able to encrypt/decrypt files using the password *Unregistered*.

When you registered, you will have been provided with a registration number. Use this, with the registered user name, in function calls to addZIP_Register and/or addUNZIP_Register. Calling addZIP_Encrypt with a password before adding files to an archive will then encrypt all further files added. Use addUNZIP_Decrypt with the appropriate password to extract encrypted files from an archive.

N.B. Remember that after calls to addZIP() and addUNZIP(), all defaults will be reset.

The short answer to this, at the moment, is that you cant. Well not with the *addZIP* Compression Libraries. PKWARE provides an excellent zip repair utility with its PKZIP package

This function generally returns the number of files processed. If -1 is returned, there is no .ZIP archive name specified. 0 indicates no files have been processed.

Warnings and errors

All warnings and error codes will be passed to the window defined by `addZIP_SetWindow` and `addUNZIP_SetWindow`. I have tried to keep the codes the same as those generated by PKZIP/PKUNZIP - registered users should refer to the documentation provided with that excellent software if my descriptions are unclear.

Unregistered (shareware) users should read the general and shareware licenses, registered users should read the general license and the relevant user license. By using the software, you indicate your agreement to the relevant license terms.

General license

The following apply to all users.

- You may not reverse engineer, change or otherwise alter any part of the software (excluding the examples) without prior written permission from the author.
- You may not produce and distribute in any way, a derived software product that may, directly or indirectly, compete with this software without prior written permission from the author.
- This software is provided as-is, and no warranty of any kind (including, but not limited to, warranty for a particular purpose) is expressed or implied. The author will not be liable for any damage, data loss etc. caused by this program.

Shareware license

If you are not a registered user, the following apply to you as additions to the general license.

- This is not free software. You may evaluate this software for a period of 30 days, after which you must register or delete the software from your hard disk. Use of this software beyond the 30 day evaluation period is expressly prohibited and violates national and international copyright law.

Private user license

If you are registered for private use only, the following apply as additions to the general license.

- The software is for your own personal use and may be used on one PC only.
- You must not disclose, distribute or make known to any other user your registration number.
- You may not distribute (free or otherwise) any software which uses the **addZIP** Compression Libraries without first upgrading to a Developer license.

Developer license

If you are registered for developer use, the following apply as additions to the general license.

- You may use this software on one PC only (unless a multiple developer license has been purchased).
- You must not disclose, distribute or make known to any other user your registration number.
- You may distribute any software which uses the **addZIP** Compression Libraries as long as it does not contravene any part of this license.
- You inform the author of any (commercial or otherwise) distributed software.

Registration brings the following benefits

- ☞ a diskette with the latest version of the **addZIP** Compression Libraries
- ☞ a registration number that allows files within an archive to be encrypted/decrypted with your own password
- ☞ free upgrades to all later versions
- ☞ the right to distribute programs which make use of the **addZIP** Compression Libraries (developer and multi-user developer licensees only)

There are three levels of registration (all prices are inclusive of post and packing)

- ☞ *private user license*. This is for the individual programmer who would like to use this software in his/her own programs but will not be distributing those same programs. The cost of this license is 30 UK pounds (50 US dollars).
- ☞ *developer license*. This is for the individual programmer who will distribute programs that incorporate the **addZIP** libraries. The cost of this license is 50 UK pounds (80 US dollars).
- ☞ *multi-user developer license*. This is for companies where the **addZIP** libraries will be used by more than one programmer. There is no limit on the number of users. The cost of this license is 100 UK pounds (160 US dollars).

To register you should send (preferably) a cheque (drawn on a UK bank) to *Stephen Darlington, 5 Clowser Close, Watgardens, Sutton, Surrey SM1 4TP, United Kingdom*. Money (most common denominations) are acceptable but please contact me first, and always send money through registered post. Alternatively US (and other overseas residents) may wish to send a cheque (drawn on a US bank) to *Steve Fulton, 1540 First Street, Manhattan Beach, CA. 90266, USA*.

When registering please provide the following information (where applicable); name, company, address, email address and registered user name.

You are actively encouraged to distribute this software amongst your friends and colleagues, upload it your favourite BBS, shareware library and ftp/WWW sites, and include it in diskette and CD-ROM software collections, provided the following conditions are met

- you distribute the exact, unmodified archive
- you do not charge for this software (apart from a modest handling fee when applicable)
- you make it clear that this software is provided as shareware (on a try before you buy basis)
- you inform the author of your actions
