

## Modified version of original ExitWin.

I made some modifications to this GREAT little utility.

First, it no longer has the repetitive "ARE YOU SURE YOU WANT TO...?" which drive me nuts in software. If I said exit, then thats what I want to do.

Second, I added the ability for command line switches. There is no about screen or help feature, so you'll have to just memorize them. When I have the time I will add them. I made these modifications in about two hours. My first attempt in my Visual Basic 2.0.

They are:

- X** - This will exit windows completely.
- R** - This option restarts Windows.
- B** - This option will reboot your computer completely.

EXAMPLE:

### **Exitwin x**

(This exits completely out of windows)

Windows will prompt you to save any unsaved work in other programs.

These options can be used from the Run command line under File Manager or Program Manager even if another copy of the software is running. If you try to run two copies WITHOUT command line switches, only one copy will stay active.

I made these changes, because I use Winclock and have it set to reboot my computer at 3:00 am every morning incase my BBS goes down. I run a Winexpress under Windows, and it can be unreliable at times.

(At least on my system).

Make any modifications you please. The copy that I received had no ones name or any information about it. There were no legal statements with it so I am going to put my version out, with the statement that it is FREEWARE and you use and or modify at your own risk.
