I set out to make a green and yellow caterpillar romping about. I put leaves on his legs and a flower for a head. This is the result. The whole thing is an accident; but colourful!

The name derives from the fact I used Polar Notation for most of the Drawing. A programmer should have little trouble figuring it out.

Finally I wrestled with converting it to a Screen Saver. It works well, though a little too eager to start when you select it as a Saver.

Just to see what its all about, first run it as an Executable. Click <Leafpol9.Exe.> Then put <Leafpol9.Scr> in C:\WINDOWS\SYSTEM and select as your Screen Saver.
