

NETDIAL 2.50 READ ME FILE

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Description: NetDial is an Internet dialer for Microsoft Windows. NetDial was made to replace packaged TCP/IP dial-up programs. NetDial will call your host, log you in and start your TCP/IP package for you, automatically. NetDial has many features, some of which are:

GENERAL:

Can be configured for up to 5 separate connections, 300-256k baud support, easy to use login scripting with user specified timeout value, can redial up to 99 times or be set to '0' for 'call until connected', on-line timer, log option to maintain a record of calls made, time spent on-line, etc, built-in call log viewer/editor, cumulative timer window, up to 5 startup programs that can be shut down on hangup/exit (if desired), can parse IP and gateway address for users with dynamic addressing.

Lots Of New Features(!):

- Cycle Dial! Can now step through connections till a connection is established.
- Can add "CYCLE" to command line to start NetDial in Cycle Dial mode, or the number 1-5 to have NetDial start up dialing connection # 1-5.
- Can now copy configuration info between connections.
- Can reset configuration data to default values
- Can automatically hangup a connection after a specified amount of time (Auto Hangup).
- Always On Top option
- Can add parameters to startup programs
- Can auto-minimize on hangup. Can also play wave file on hangup
- Script timeout is now optional. Value is now based on minutes (instead of seconds).
- Status window will now wrap lines longer than the window.
- Full hardcopy documentation (Word 6 format)
- Registration can now also be completed online at CompuServe through the Shareware Registration Forum (GO SWREG). NetDial's ID # is 3528.
