Usage:

STool SCREEN/M, LIST=L/S, TOFRONT=F/S, TOBACK=B/S, CONSTRING=C/S, WINSIZE=W/S
 SCREEN/M screentitle or pattern (casesensitive!)
 LIST=L/S list screens
 TOFRONT=F/S bring object to front
 TOBACK=B/S send object to back
 CONSTRING=C/S window size as CON:-like string
 WINSIZE=W/S window size as info-string

EXAMPLES:

STool LIST	- list all open screens
STool LIST #?i#?	- dito but only those with "i" in Title
STool TOFRONT "Public Screen: Grapevine.1"	- send GV-screen to front
STool TOBACK *Grape*	- send it back again
STool WINSIZE	- tell me current window- dimensions
STool CONSTRING	- window-dimensions for batch-processing
