

## RUN NAME

## RUN

run - Run a Windows program from a DOS prompt within Windows.

## SYNOPSIS

**run** command [parameters] [&]

## DESCRIPTION

If Windows is running, **run** passes the current directory and command [parameters] [&] to the scheduler **sched**. **Sched** will run command [parameters] as a child proces in the indicated directory. The optional & symbol indicates that the program will run minimized.

If Windows is not running, **win** command [parameters] will be executed.

In order to use this program, the scheduler must have been loaded. Insert into the section [**windows**] in the file **win.ini**:

**load=sched.exe**

## BUGS

If the environment variable **TEMP** is changed after Windows has been started, communication between **run** and **sched** will be lost.

**Sched** uses the environment variable **PATH** as it was when Windows was started.

Changes made to the environment after Windows has been started, have no effect on the program to be run. The program inherirts the environment as it was when Windows was started.
