

# **GEOSoft ToDOS for Windows 3.1**

GEOSoft ToDOS is a small utility program that simply puts an icon on the bottom of your screen that, when double clicked, will load a DOS Window. It is shareware, and after 14 days, it should be registered. For more information on registering, see the **About...** box in the program itself. This version is fairly simple, it will load anything contained in `TODOS.PIF` file. This default file is set up to load `COMMAND.COM` when clicked. This can be changed by editing the `TODOS.PIF` file. The next version will allow you to specify a PIF file and an icon for each instance of ToDOS, and it will respond to DDE messages as well. (The time until these are added depends on when a Windows 3.1 version of my compiler is available)

(Note: This version DOES require Microsoft Windows version 3.1. I honestly have no clue why it won't run under Windows 3.0; it doesn't use any 3.1 specific features. There is apparently a bug in the Windows 3.0 command that executes DOS files that causes it to be unable to find the file under certain circumstances. The identical program works flawlessly under Windows 3.1. Unlike most programs, this one actually works with Windows 3.1)
