

Play All Sounds!

Play All Sounds! is a simple program that plays all the sounds in all open resource files. Most likely, this will include the sounds in the System file as well as any sound resource files that are open with a program like Suitcase. With the new Macintosh systems, sounds are more popular than ever. **Play All Sounds!** is a simple way to play all your sounds from the desktop.

Contents of the Play All Sounds! Package

- The Play All Sounds! application is, of course, the primary item in the package.
- The “Play All Sounds! READ ME!” file is this document.
- The “Jump Start! Blurb” file is a text file containing a description of Jump Start!, a utility distributed by Insanely Great Software.
- The “Playin’ Possum! Blurb” file is a text file containing a description of Playin’ Possum!, a “prank” program distributed by Insanely Great Software.

Distribution

You may freely distribute Play All Sounds! to individuals or user groups as long as you include all the files that are listed above without any changes. This version may also be uploaded to any commercial or non-profit bulletin board, as long as all files are included. Instructions:

To Install a sound into Playin’ Possum:

- 1) Make sure all your sound files are open. If you are using Suitcase, make sure that the resource files that contain the sounds are open.
- 2) Run the application. It will play all the sounds and quit back to the Finder.
