Payoffs

When the Slot Machine is finished spinning a combination of images will be presented. The following table will list the combinations and the payoff. The payoff is a multiple of the bet placed. For example if a player bets \$.50 and payoff is 5. The player wins \$2.50.



How to Play

This section will explain how to play the slot machine. The game is played by clicking on certain object on the screen. The clicking will activate the action of the object. Following are the objects and the actions the occur when the object is clicked on:



This is a quarter. When a user clicks on the quarter it will change the bet for the user. The bet defaults to \$.25. Each click will raise the bet \$.25. The max bet is five quarters of \$1.25. The next click resets the be to \$.25.



This is the arm of the Slot Machine. When the red handle of the arm is clicked. The Slot Machine is started. The Slot Machine will go at a random pace until the user releases the mouse button. The Slot Machine will spin for up to 10 seconds. How long a user holds down the arm determines the chance of the play.
