


Chat2 uses named pipes to chat.
It is smaller and faster than MS Chat,
and connects better over a RAS connection.
It also allows many people to chat together.
Chat2 requires that some computer act as a
server. (i.e. must be running Chat2s)
It could be your local machine, or any one
on the network. When someone connects
to the server, the server automatically starts
a copy of the client so that you can chat.
The server is small, (17k) so everyone could
keep a copy of the server running on their
machine all the time. (i.e. put it in Startup)

This is the Window where
you will do your corresponding.

This is the Window that allows you to enter your choices to connect to a Chat2 server.



You can type in a server name (any machine running a copy of Chat2s server) Chat2 will then save the name in its server list



Or you can simply click on the combobox arrow to drop down a list of known servers and choose one from the list

This is the name you will go by in the chat session.
Chat2 automatically puts your NT username here.
You can change it to anything you want by simply
highlighting the field and typing in your choice.

Click on this button to have Chat2 attempt to connect you using the server and client name you have entered. If it is a new server name, Chat2 will add it to the list.

This button will cause Chat2
to take no action and quit.

This will bring up this help file.

This is where you will see the text
typed by all connected Chat2 users.

This is where you will enter
the text you wish to send.

Clicking on this button will send the text in the write Window.
It is not necessary to do so, simply hitting RETURN after you
have finished entering your text will also send it to all users.

This will allow you to set the
background colors for your Window.

This will allow you to set the
font and size for your window.

This will allow you to print the text
in the read window to your printer.

This will allow you to save the
text in the read Window to a file.

This will allow you to mail the contents of the read Window.

This will bring up this help file.

This will exit Chat2 and send the message to the any other connected Chat2 users.

This will allow you to scroll back through the text that has already been written in the read Window.
