Version **6.88** and **6.89** were for internal release only.

Version **6.90** incorporates the following changes:

The most important change concerns our internal development policy. With version 6.90 we have abandoned Symantec's Think development environment and from now on will use only Metrowerks' CodeWarrior. Previously, we had maintained our code in both development environments simultaneously. We have tested AutoPay version 6.90 thoroughly, but please note that the 6.90 code resource is the first release version to be compiled under CodeWarrior, so if anything unusual appears, please let us know.

Other changes:

- **New preferences file format.**

The Digital Money Preferences file now uses a new file format to provide compatibility between AutoPay and our new electronic registration card product, AutoReg.

- **All memory deallocated at AutoPay termination.**

Previous versions of AutoPay were less careful about disposing of pointers, handles, and resources at the termination of the program. This sometimes left your heap fragmented. Thanks to Mark Hamilton of Intelligent Technologies for pointing this out and helping with the fix.

- **Customer information screen redesigned.**

New layout for a fairly dense screen. Also, when you hit tab (or return) text fields are now jumped to in the correct sequence.

- **New logo.**

Color brightened on the Digital Money, Inc. logo.

- **Enhanced transaction protocol.**

Modem transactions now use Digital Money Protocol version 3.0 to communicate with dial-in server. Enhanced robustness and error-checking.
