

Version 4.5 New Features

Super Fast Saving

- DOCMaker has traditionally been plagued with slow saving - No Longer!

Table of Contents

- TOC font and bullet character definable
- TOC window is floating and resizable in documents
- Command-L adds all selection text to TOC entry (250 chars max)

Apple Events Supported

- Stand-alone document supports AppleEvents
(see dictionary from Script Editor)
 - "Number of Chapters" returns number of chapters
 - "Number of Contents" return number of TOC entries
 - "Go to chapter" switches to chapter with scroll value
 - "Go to contents" switches to TOC item location
 - "Do Find" issues a text find in document

New Hot Picture Actions (Document Buttons)

- "Go to chapter" now has optional scroll down value
- "Output text from single chapter" hot picture action
- "Return to last position" hot picture action
- "Open TOC" from hot picture action
- "Next chapter" from hot picture action
- "Previous chapter" from hot picture action

- "Send Apple Event" from hot picture action

Other Picture Features

- Pictures now have optional no-print attribute
- Copied pictures now maintains original settings
- Option-cmd click to select pictures in DOCMaker
- Option-cmd double-click to set picture actions in DOCMaker
- Added "Select After Paste" to preferences

Miscellaneous New Features

- Footer space now available for main text body printing

when not being used.
- Buttons added to screen size dialog for getting
current window width & height
- Custom chap scrollbar/control added to documents
- Text copying from the documents may be optionally set
- Drag and drop is available in docs when text copying is active
- Drag and drop is available in DOCMaker
- Color background for document window definable
- Hand cursor in document when over picture with action
- Find/change fonts in DOCMaker

- Find/change status to DOCMaker
- Preferred and minimum RAM size set in prefs dialog

Fixes

- Fixed problems caused by saving docs with empty chapters
- Show note picture action always displays note in window
- Movie play routines reworked
- Movie centers horizontally on calling picture
- Movie window always in screen
